- 13 (b) The commission may determine that a person who meets the
- 14 requirements under Section 1701.307(a) is ineligible for
- 15 appointment as a peace officer based on events that occur after the
- 16 person meets the requirements in Section 1701.307(a) but before the
- 17 person is appointed.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
