- 9 SECTION 2. Subsections (a), (b), (c), (e), and (f), Section
- 10 551.009, Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The Department of State Health Services shall contract
- 12 with the local mental health authority serving the Hill Country
- 13 area, including Kerr County, to operate [implement a crisis
- 14 stabilization unit pilot project by establishing and operating] a
- 15 crisis stabilization unit on the grounds of the Kerrville State
- 16 Hospital as provided by this section. The unit must be a 16-bed
- 17 facility separate from the buildings used by the Kerrville State
- 18 Hospital.
- 19 (b) The department shall <u>include provisions in the</u> contract
- 20 requiring [with] the local mental health authority [serving the
- 21 Hill Country area, including Kerr County, | to [operate the crisis
- 22 stabilization unit. The department shall ensure that the crisis
- 23 stabilization unit provides short-term residential treatment,
- 24 including medical and nursing services, designed to reduce a

- 1 patient's acute symptoms of mental illness and prevent a patient's
- 2 admission to an inpatient mental health facility.
- 3 (c) The local mental health authority shall contract with
- 4 Kerrville State Hospital to provide food service, laundry service,
- 5 and lawn care[, and equipment rental to the crisis stabilization
- 6 unit. The local mental health authority may contract with
- 7 Kerrville State Hospital to provide pharmaceutical services for the
- 8 crisis stabilization unit].
- 9 (e) The local mental health authority operating the crisis
- 10 stabilization unit under contract shall use, for the purpose of
- 11 operating the 16-bed unit, the money appropriated to the department
- 12 for operating 16 beds in state hospitals that is allocated to the
- 13 local mental health authority. The department shall ensure that
- 14 the local mental health authority retains the remainder of the
- 15 local authority's state hospital allocation that is not used for
- 16 operating the 16-bed unit. The department may allocate additional
- 17 funds appropriated to the department for state hospitals to the
- 18 crisis stabilization unit [pilot project].
- 19 (f) The department shall reduce the number of beds the
- 20 department operates in the state hospital system by 16. The
- 21 department, in collaboration with the local mental health
- 22 authority, shall ensure that the 16 beds in the crisis
- 23 stabilization unit are made available to other mental health
- 24 authorities for use as designated by the department.
- 25 SECTION 3. Subsections (g) and (h), Section 551.009, Health
- 26 and Safety Code, are repealed.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act does not make an appropriation. A

- 1 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,
- 2 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental
- 3 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the
- 4 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the

- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect August 31, 2009.
