

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the approval of expenditures of certain incumbent
3 county or precinct officers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 130.908, Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 130.908. APPROVAL OF SPENDING BY CERTAIN COUNTY AND
8 PRECINCT OFFICERS [~~COMMISSIONERS~~]. If [~~a person other than~~] an
9 incumbent county or precinct officer [~~commissioner~~] is not
10 renominated or is not reelected [~~elected~~] to the county or precinct
11 office [~~of county commissioner~~] of a county [~~with a population of~~
12 ~~less than 50,000~~], during the time following the date the results of
13 the official canvass of the primary or election returns are
14 announced, the commissioners court must approve any expenditure
15 [~~expenditures~~] by the incumbent county or precinct officer
16 [~~commissioner~~] who was not renominated or reelected that is over an
17 amount set by the commissioners court.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
