The former Denton Chapter President & TxSSAR Historian, started his presentation with a song, and then explained that the substance of the remainder of his oral conversation would be under three topics: *The Origin & Religious Celebration of*

Christmas, Traditions of Christmas and Amazing Number of December Events between the years - 1773 and 1783.

During the first segment Dr. Johnson explained how, on December 25th, Christopher Columbus' ship Santa Maria ran aground at Espanola & thus established the "City of Nativity". During the first and second segments of his presentation, the former TxSSAR Color Guard Commander, passed around pictures depicting scenes of religious & festive events held >> during the 1700s.

James concluded the third segment by relating true tales of many historical December events, especially the strange one of George Washington crossing the Delaware December 25, 1776 - (Nine times ???)






SPECIAL NOTICE #2
