

Kleberg Letters by Date of People, Places, and Events in Corpus Christi

April 18, 1884—"Corpus Christi fever is increasing"

May 13, 1884—Court favored Collins in case (about King's case in court)

—change in the Kleberg firm name

May 27, 1884 —Jury returns verdict in favor of Mr. Collins; Because of court error new trial granted

—Theatrical performances twice every week & musical concerts and dancing at the Pavillion once every week

—invited to a sailing party given for benefit of some visitors from Monterrey, including a Mexican Senorita

June 4, 1884

Goes to Supreme Court to represent Laredo land suit

inquired at Collins for her letter (need to identify place called Collins here)

Judge Stayton and letter concerning candidacy for Congress (Galveston News has a copy of letter?)

Goes to Supreme Court to retry Laredo suit lost in spring, involves 150,000 acres—his fee will be over 20,000 acres if he wins

Friends from De Will Co. come to visit

July 6, 1884

Laredo Excursionists going to Pavilion to lunch and dance

Judge Murphy died last night

July 25, 1884

Democratic nomination in papers

- Mr. ???? collector of customs at Eagle Pass
- July 27, 1887 Hon. Geo P. Finley is making a speech on front gallery of hotel in Corpus Christi
- Old friend M for supper and a first class ticket for a front seat at the show
- August 17, 1887 military unchivalrous to Henrietta by quartering themselves in house
- Dr. Spohn given a gray horse (Jesse James horse?)
- Mr. Dougherty to send horse to Spohn
