# STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT CENTER

The Student Money Management Center, an outreach program administered by the Division for Student Development, provides tools and solutions students need to achieve financial freedom.

Staff members partner with students from their first day on campus through graduation to address personal financial and money management needs and to start planning for a secure financial future. In addition to educational workshops and seminars, the Center provides confidential personalized money management consultations.

At the Student Money Management Center you can:

- Talk to trained professionals about your personal finances
- Learn how to establish and manage credit
- Create a financial survival plan for college
- Understand your credit report and credit score
- Plan for tuition and fee payments
- Research housing options
- Plan for expenses during or after college
- Compare future employer benefits packages
- Graduate with a plan for repaying your debt

## Student Centered

The Student Money Management Center provides personal financial and money management education to students. In addition to workshops, seminars, and clinics, we provide confidential individual financial consultations and planning services. All of our services are free for University of North Texas students.

## Free Workshops, Seminars, and Clinics

Throughout each academic semester the Student Money Management Center sponsors FREE workshops, seminars, and clinics covering a wide variety of personal financial and money management topics. Some of the workshops are based in theory, some are based in methodology, but all of the training opportunities include plenty of tips and strategies that students can apply to their personal financial situations. Educational opportunities are open to all members of the UNT community.

## In the Green Speakers

Interested in having a Student Money Management Center speaker for your class, group or student organization? The Student Money Management Center hosts a speakers bureau known as In the Green Speakers. Requests for a presentation by an In the Green Speaker can be placed by contacting the Center's administrative office. Please submit requests no later than 10 to 15 business days prior to the intended presentation date.

Presentations are excellent introductions to personal financial planning topics such as goal setting, organizing finances, creating a budget, cash and credit management, insurance, student loan debt retirement, housing options, and job offers.



## Free Personal Consultations

The Student Money Management Center is dedicated to serving students with individualized financial counseling opportunities. Students gain insight and clarity in all aspects of their personal financial situation by scheduling a personal consultation. All information is held in strict confidence.

Initial consultations are scheduled for 90 minutes to allow the staff to gain a general assessment of a student's current financial situation and to focus on the most immediate areas of interest. This consultation will conclude with workable, interactive worksheets and a list of tasks for the student to complete in order to begin a path to financial success.
