We offer daily/weekly rentals, full service set up and delivery of display booth materials, and custom creation of graphic elements to fit your every need. If you or your university department already owns a display booth unit, the Center for Media production would be happy to create any and all photography or graphic elements that you may need for your special event.

Display Kiosks

We have several different types of displays available including a number of freestanding units custom built by CMP. They have a total of 32 square feet of presentation space on four sides. The kiosks feature CMP's "signature" fabric panel boards that enable rapid set up and take down of all graphic elements. These units have a solid "permanent" look but are easily portable. CMP staff does all delivery, set up and takedown of the kiosks. There is NO CHARGE for use of the kiosks, however, a \$300 refundable damage deposit is required. These units are only available for use with CMP prepared graphics. Additional transportation fees may apply for off campus use. One working week is required for presentation preparation. This time is necessary for planning, designing and/or acquisition and production of the graphic elements. Currently The Center for Media Production has a total of five kiosks available for campus use but please call ahead to guarantee rental dates and times.

Signature Fabric Panel Units

These portable, lightweight units can be built to your unique specifications and include custom graphics and photographs to create a display for many different uses. Banners

Our table top display unit rents for \$25a day. This price does not reflect the additional charges for graphics, delivery, set up or other incidental costs. Due to its compact size and ease of transportation, university renters can pick up and assemble this display by themselves if they desire. This identical display unit would normally rent for over \$250 a day from sign and display companies in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. Audio Services

Whether on location, in our studio or in of our professional sound booths, The Center for Media Production specializes in recording voices for narration or spoken word material. In addition to a matched pair of Neumann TLM-102 microphones, CMP utilizes a wide variety of professional handheld, shotgun or livelier microphones.

Additional location or studio signal processing is available though finalizer Plus and all production areas are monitored with Genelec speakers.

Audio production output options include: DAT, CD, minidisk, video and audio cassette as well as direct output to QuckTime, REAL and Windows Media for file or live wb cast distribution via world wide web.

Audio Production – Location or studio recording, processing and mixing

Talent – CMP works closely with a number of versatile, professional and semi-professional voices from the Forth Worth/Dallas and Denton areas. CMP staff will help you find the right voice talent to match your specific project and budget needs. If you choose to do your own voice talent, the Center for Media Production will work with you to get the best possible results from your efforts.

Production Music and Sound Effects – CMP maintains a full CD library of production music and sound effects for use in audio and video productions.

Real Time Transfers – Audio duplication that takes place in real time – that is, the real time it takes to play a tape or album and duplicate it to another medium. Transfers requiring editing and/or processing of the original material will be done at the standard audio production rates.

Older Technologies – CMP offers limited support of some older audio technologies. Duplication to DAT, CD, cassette, etc. is still available from reel-to-reel tape formats. High speed audiocassette duplication is also available. We cannot, however, play 78 phonograph records or reel-to-reel tapes at speeds lower than 7 ½ ips.

Audio/Video

The Center for Media Production's Audio/Video department is a full service production facility featuring location or studio recording, videotaping, postproduction and tape duplication.

We offer video duplication to or from BetaCamSP, S-VHS, VHS, Hi-8, 8mm, International formats (PAL, Secam), Mini DVD and even ¾" U-Matic. VHS duplication includes labeling and sleeve design and production. Custom packaging is also available.

We also offer video and audio prepared for distribution via the world wide web. Live events from the CMP studio or remote campus locations may be distributed through the campus LAN (broadband) UNT Video Conferencing Networking and NTTV (Denton Cable Channel 22). Consult with our professionals on your upcoming production and videotape duplication needs.

In addition to providing the finest in audio/video creative expertise, the CMP technical services staff maintains the center's extensive inventory of broadcast quality video and audio production equipment. Technical services supervisor Don Anderson is an engineer for all of CMP's studio and remote location productions. The CMP technical services department provides the UNT system with consultation, design and engineering for the

installation of audiovisual monitoring and recording and sound support systems. AV equipment repair and preventive maintenance is also available.

Streaming Video

Streaming video is where we videotape your event or presentation and upload it onto a website of your choosing. Usually it's the official UNT site, but we can also load onto your department or home site as well. This enables your audience to view your event at any time for as long as you wish. The center for Media Production has already produced many streaming media presentations including Dr. Pohls inauguration, seminars on military history on the UNT site and homecoming/tailgating information for the Screaming Eagles.
