--Fairhaven has begun the pioneering effort to develop the "Heritage Series" of super hybrid wine grapes. The genetic base for this project is sourced from Fairhaven's exceptionally rare American hybrid collection. Our breeding vineyard is a living history of American hybrids that now numbers over 2000 of these extraordinary vines. In November of 2009 Lomanto became the first wine produced in the Heritage Series.

--genetic work that is currently underway at Fairhaven is geared toward the development of heat and drought tolerant, disease resistant varieties for wine production in the most demanding environmental conditions. The first series of new hybrids are expected to be released to the public in 2012.

Red Road Vineyard—Naples (Mt Pleasant) first of five blocks of vines were planted in 2001. These Pierce disease resistant varietals that serve as the base of our Signature wines winery's brick structure, originally built in the 1890s, housed the first power and ice company in Northeast Texas. What is an AVA?

An American Viticultural Area (AVA) is an officially recognized "delimited grape growing region distinguishable by geographical features, the boundaries of which have been recognized and defined" through a petition process (Code of Federal Regulations).

An AVA designation is one type of appellation permitted on American wine labels to provide consumers with information on the growing locale of grapes used in the labeled wine. Petitions for new viticultural areas are considered for approval by the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau with evidence that the proposed name of the viticultural area is locally or nationally known as referring to the area specified; the boundaries are as specified; and the geographical features (climate, soil, elevation, physical features, etc.) distinguish the viticultural features of the proposed area from surrounding areas.
