There are various small events going on, I'm sure. But you just missed the second-best zydeco festival opportunity of the year: That would be the recently concluded Houston International Festival, which devoted one stage exclusively to zydeco for one day of each of the previous weekends. I do know on May 15th in Houston at San Miguel Plaza there is an all-day outdoor zydeco festival. Other than that, I am not aware of any big zydeco events on the horizon (beyond the normal weekly routines, such as Sunday night jam sessions at the Big Easy nightclub in Houston--or the Saturday afternoon sessions at Pe-Te's Cajun Barbecue down near the entrance to Ellington Field).
