Male Voice.....The history of Denton reads like a history of the Old West. Denton County was established in 1846 by the Texas Legislature and named for an early Texas settler John B. Denton. John B. Denton was a lawyer, a Methodist Preacher and an Indian Fighter. He was killed in 1841 during a raid on an Indian Camp along Village Creek in what is today Arlington, Texas. Denton was the only member of the volunteer militia killed in the raid, he was initially buried beside Oliver Creek in Justin, his body was later moved to John Chisum's Bolivar ranch in Northern Denton County.

5 years after Denton's death, Denton County was named in his honor, and in 1857 the city of Denton

was established and recognized as the county seat.

Denton's early years were a rough and tumble time.

state, the University of North Texas. A few years later a
women's college was founded as the College of
Industrial Arts. Today that college is the largest
women's educational institution in the country,
Texas Woman's University.... making Denton the
educational hub of the North Texas area. Today the
universities bring Denton International recognition for
their programs in music, nursing, physical therapy,
education and business. And recent building projects
at both Universities are preparing the schools for a new
century of educating students from around the world.**

Even today the courthouse serves as the seat of Denton county government. County Commissioners meet every Tuesday morning in the commissioners courtroom on the second floor of the courthouse. Although closed to the general public since 1986 a spiral staircase on the third floor leads to the clock tower and observation alcoves. Outside the courthouse is the grave of John B. Denton, whose body was moved from John Chisum's ranch to the Denton County Square in 1901.

During the early summer local musicians play during the Noon Concerts on the Square series every Wednesday while business people and visitors enjoy their lunch. The Dog Days of Summer are celebrated on the second Saturday in June while the second Saturday in September is County Seat Saturday, a celebration of days gone by when people used to come to the square to visit and shop. Booths,

bands and food make County Seat Saturday a unique celebration of Denton's heritage.

The Death of John Bunyan Denton

Most of the fighting between settlers and Native Americans was carried on, not by rangers or any other official government forces, but by ad hoc bands of settlers hurriedly formed into forces that resembled the deputized posses often depicted in western movies. North Texas militia forces, usually a few dozen strong, might be gone from home for days as they rode to punish the Indians and retrieve livestock lost in earlier Indian raids.

In the spring and summer of 1841 three militia sorties rode from the Clarksville and Paris communities into the cross timbers and Grand Prairie of the upper Trinity Valley to engage the Indians. One group that rode out in May was made up of several prominent northeast Texans. They included General E. H. Tarrant, Claiborne Chisum, John Coffey, John B. Denton, and John L. Lovejoy, who later opened one of the first businesses in the city of Denton and was known affectionately by local citizens as "Uncle Johnny." This militia unit chased Kichai Indians from their homes near Village Creek, in present-day north Tarrant County near Fort Worth. They burned the grass huts of the village, recovered some livestock, and lost one member of their band in the fighting. John B. Denton was killed.

Interestingly, it is possible that had there been more than one man lost in that action, he might never have become so noted and well-remembered as to become the namesake of both the county and city that bear his name.

John Bunyan Denton was born in Tennessee but grew up in southern Indiana. He came to Texas in 1837 as a circuit riding Methodist Minister. His salary as a circuit rider was so low that he asked to be "located" as a minister. He was granted that request and assigned to

in the collection were destroyed.

With Hedgecoxe gone there was no one with which colonists could file their claims. Consequently, the legislature in February of 1853 allowed colonists, for the first time, to file their claims directly with the state land office. Later legislation also allowed them to obtain title to their land by filing in the prescribed manner with county clerks in counties like Denton, Dallas, Tarrant, and Cooke.

Although the Texas Land and Emigration Company faded from active participation in Denton County affairs after 1853, the company left a highly significant legacy. As a result of its contract, for almost ten years, all legal settlement in Denton County came from outside Texas rather than from adjoining land. Eighty-nine percent of the 641 Denton County residents in the 1850 census were colonists, a higher percentage than in any other county. Almost all of the other eleven percent were relatives

and friends of the colonists. A high percentage were from the upper South and the lower Midwest. They were small farmers with few slaves, only ten in the county in 1850. Most had been prairie farmers where they came from and the prairies of north central Texas must have looked very much like the land they had lived on before.

One interesting and very direct legacy came from Hedgecoxe. He named many of the creeks in southwestern Denton County. Elizabeth, Harriet, and Catherine Creeks were for his wife and two daughters, Oliver Creek for him, and Trail Creek for his dog. Although he was exiled in 1852, he later returned and his family had large land holdings in Collin County in 1870.

By the early 1850s several small communities existed in Denton County, but no towns or cities. Only Pilot Point and Alton could be called villages. Hebron, Little Elm, which got a post office in 1845, Holford's Prairie, Chinn's

Chapter Two

Timber Settlement and County Growth: 1846-1865

In 1846 the Texas state legislature created Denton County and directed county residents to choose between two different tracts of land, both located near the center of the county, as a location for the county seat. Regardless of the choice, the town would be named Pinckneyville, either after the new governor of Texas, J. Pinckney Henderson or a prominent family named Pinkney who lived near Lewisville. Although there is no record of a vote, the original county seat was located near Pecan Creek about two and one-half miles south-southeast of Denton's courthouse square today. There was no settlement there and no courthouse or any county buildings were ever built at the site. In those days, sessions of district court were held only twice a year and lasted, at most, for only a few days. Consequently most of the time there was

nothing going on at Pinckneyville.

Since the place was not close to where county settlers lived, and had poor drainage as well, in 1848 the state legislature moved the county seat about three miles southeastward and renamed it Alton. Local residents never liked the name of Pinckneyville. This site, in the vicinity of the present community of Corinth, proved unsatisfactory because of a lack of drinking water. As a result, at the next session of the legislature, members were persuaded to pass a bill to move the county seat southwestward to the residence of Alexander E. Cannon on Hickory Creek. As Denton historian Clarence Bridges noted, Jesse Loving thought that "they moved to this place New Alton because of a spring that ran out of a bluff, the worst water I ever tasted."

bring Denton International recognition for their
programs in music, nursing, physical therapy,

Two Different Men:

Jessie Chisholm (1805-1868)

John Simpson Chisum (1824-1884)

Jessie Chisholm and John Chisum, two men who often are confused in our time.

Jessie Chisholm is the more famous, John Chisum the more successful. I have found no record that the two ever met, but it's an open question.

JESSIE CHISHOLM

Jessie Chisholm was the son of a Scotsman and a Cherokee woman. He left Tennessee and was a resident of Ft. Gibson, OK by 1836. There, he became a well-known guide, trader and interpreter between the whites and several Indian tribes.

Jessie was a friend of President Sam Houston of Texas and more than once he helped arrange peace parlays in North Texas. But, after 1858, he seems to have avoided any trips into Texas. Remember, he was half Indian and regularly traded and worked with the Plains tribes. He may have felt threatened south of the Red River.

During the Civil War, Jessie first assisted the confederates in approaching the Indians as allies. By 1864 he was living in Wichita, KN, and working with Union forces as an interpreter. He also continued to operate a small store. A creek in Wichita is named after Chisholm.

At the close of the war, Chisholm followed his well-worn path back to Oklahoma to set up a store on the Canadian River. The heavily loaded wagons left clear ruts that even cow drovers could follow.

Jessie Chisholm died in 1868. Only later did the trail take his name and become famous. Chisholm probably would be amused - and probably want payment for - the linking of his name to a series of ruts. Very little of Western history was ever planned. It just "took place."

JOHN SIMPSON CHISUM

John Simpson Chisum was born in Tennessee. His Family moved to Texas and by 1852 young John was clerk of Lamar County.

He thought cattle trading would mean good money. So, backed by S.K. Fowler, he acquired several thousand longhorns and claimed land along Clear Creek

just north of present day Bolivar. It was unfenced prairie with good grass and water. His herd reached 5,000 beeves by 1860 and he had made small drives to Louisiana and Arkansas. He was regarded as a very wealthy man.

His holdings made him exempt from the Confederate draft and in 1862 he made a drive to furnish beef for Vicksburg, MS. Subsequently, he showed little interest in doing business with the Rebel government. He was a cool, clever businessman who never carried a gun (but did hire gunslingers.) He was never a "cow person." He was a trader, first and last.

Chisum left Bolivar in late 1863 and moved his herd to the fork of the Concho River near present day San Angelo. His operation prospered and one of his regular buyers was Charles Goodnight, who took the cattle into New Mexico and Colorado.

Following Goodnight's lead, Chisum once again moved west. In 1872 he settled thousands of cows along a 100 mile stretch of the Pecos River in Lincoln County, NM. By 1875 he owned all or part of 60,000 animals. To cut down on theft and fraud, he made a double cut in each cow's ear. That flapping ear became known as a "jingle bob." He also used a distinctive brand called the "Long Rail."

A power struggle developed in Lincoln County that involved John Chisum. Both his lawyer and a business partner were killed in the subsequent gun fights. One of the gunmen involved was the infamous William Bonney aka "Billy the Kid."

Chisum lost a great deal of money and influence, but he died peacefully and is buried in Paris, TX.

DEFINING THE CHISHOLM TRAIL

In the spring of 1867 the Kansas & Pacific Railway reached the hamlet of Abilene, KN. Joe McCoy built extensive loading pens and circulated fliers stating that he was a cash buyer of Texas longhorn, FOB Abilene.

The first herd going north belonged to O.W. Wheeler of San Antonio. He crossed into Oklahoma at Red River Station and subsequently followed Jessie Chisholm's tracks to Kansas.

It was a good trail and that regular route continued in use from 1867 to a decline and close by 1884. Millions of longhorns were moved up the trail with little interference by Indians.

The Texas trails were like the roots of a tree, coming from everywhere and aimed at Red River Station. The area between Denton and Decatur was the most heavily traveled of the Texas routes.

Unfortunately, Jessie Chisholm missed his moment in history. He died in 1868 before the great traffic rush. He is buried in Oklahoma.

An average herd moving up the Chisholm trail included 2,500 head of cattle accompanied by 10 cowboys, a cook, a wrangler (horse minder) and the trail boss. It was just a business, we added the romance.

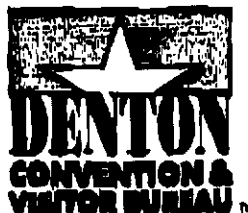
