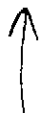



Paul -

I've finished my meeting with our public safety director and wanted to let you know what we discussed:

1. We will close Chapel Drive at both ends (Bell Avenue and our library parking lot); you can bring the vehicles in on Chapel Drive at Bell Avenue and park on the street in front of the chapel - nothing on the stone sidewalks or grass, please. We will have a police officer at each barricade; officers will arrive around 5 a.m.
2. Parking has been shifted to two other sites: in our library parking lot on Oakland and Locust Streets in Denton; and in one of our housing parking lots on Bell Avenue (the north end of campus), just north of Chapel Drive. Please do NOT invite guests to park in the lots on University Drive that we previously discussed.
3. I will ask to have signs made and posted on Bell and Oakland to direct visitors to the two parking sites.
4. We will ask to have the sprinklers turned off around the chapel that day.
5. We will have at least two officers in the immediate area of the chapel to monitor and assist with directions, etc.

6. I've told both the head of public safety and the head of facilities management that you will supply your own generator, that you will have several trucks and that you will bring an RV for make-up, all of which will be parked in front of the Little Chapel. We are not planning to have any vehicles on the drive behind the building.
7. We will have the area picked up and the chapel will be open. A bathroom can be used in the back of the chapel, if needed, and I will request that adequate supplies be placed in that facility. I also will inform housing that someone may wander in to one of the housing facilities looking for a restroom.
8. The news crew also will shoot the renewal of wedding vows in the chapel, which will involve cameras and perhaps some lighting. That activity will not involve moving any of the pews or historic accoutrements in the building. The rooms on the side in the front also may be used for changing, etc. (You'll need to evaluate that versus bathroom access on the east side.)
9. I've told them that you are planning to tape off an area that will keep audience members out of your staging area. We will not be marking off that site.

I think that these items summarize what we discussed with you and what our folks are doing in response. If you have thought of anything else or if anything is misstated (or if I forgot something!), please let me know ASAP. I'm having three teeth extracted tomorrow and won't be back until Thursday.

I'm also doing a news release today for distribution. Denton Online already has the details (and will correct the parking information), and I am posting the faculty/staff newsletter for TWU late today, which includes a front-page story on it as well.

DENTON GMT SEGMENT IDEAS

- ▶ **Bob Montgomery - Interim Collections Director, Courthouse Museum-on-the-Square**
An accomplished storyteller and historian, Bob is prepared to give a quick tour of the Museum (very impressive and unique), as well as an entertaining history of the landmark Courthouse (widely recognized as one of the most beautiful in Texas), its role in Denton's rich Texas history and how it serves as the symbolic and physical heart of the city. *Possible to pre-record some footage from here for airing on 9/3 show?*
- ▶ **County Seat Saturday** - coming up Sept. 12; Denton's most popular community event, celebrating the heritage and community spirit of the town. Family entertainment for all: dancers, fiddling contest, cowboy poets, arts & crafts...
- ▶ **Cooking segment:** Martha Len Nelson can cook on-air. Longtime Denton resident; some of her recipes are used at the Greenhouse restaurant, a new trendy eatery.
- ▶ **Storytelling:** Denton is known for its annual Storytelling Festival in March. One of Denton's most notable storytellers could perform to the audience; is well-known for his portrayal of John B. Denton during festival. It is necessary for the viewers to see audience reaction to get a good idea of the magic and entertainment value of storytelling (not just for children).
- ▶ **Music:** Denton known for its music - jazz would suit the widest audience. One O'Clock Lab Band could perform; also, Pops Carter and the Funkmonsters - Pops is elderly, and exudes a certain charm; still in the swing with his rhythm & blues band.
- ▶ **Shopping:** Extensive array of shops available here, from antiques to art to unique gift items. Denton Main Street rep can point out some of the unique places shopaholics mustn't miss.
- ▶ **Gallery night:** One thing Denton offers to promote its rich visual arts program. Twice a year, sponsors hold a free event during which visitors can tour participating galleries in and around the Courthouse Square. A Main Street Association representative is available to discuss how it works and why folks enjoy it so much.
- ▶ **Horse Country:** Few outside of Denton know about the county's international fame for breeding and training a wide variety of horses. A past Kentucky Derby winner even hails from a Denton ranch (this area is second only to the Louisville/Lexington, KY area for volume of championship horse ranches). Horse country is beautiful and tours are available to the public. At least one ranch is open directly to the public.

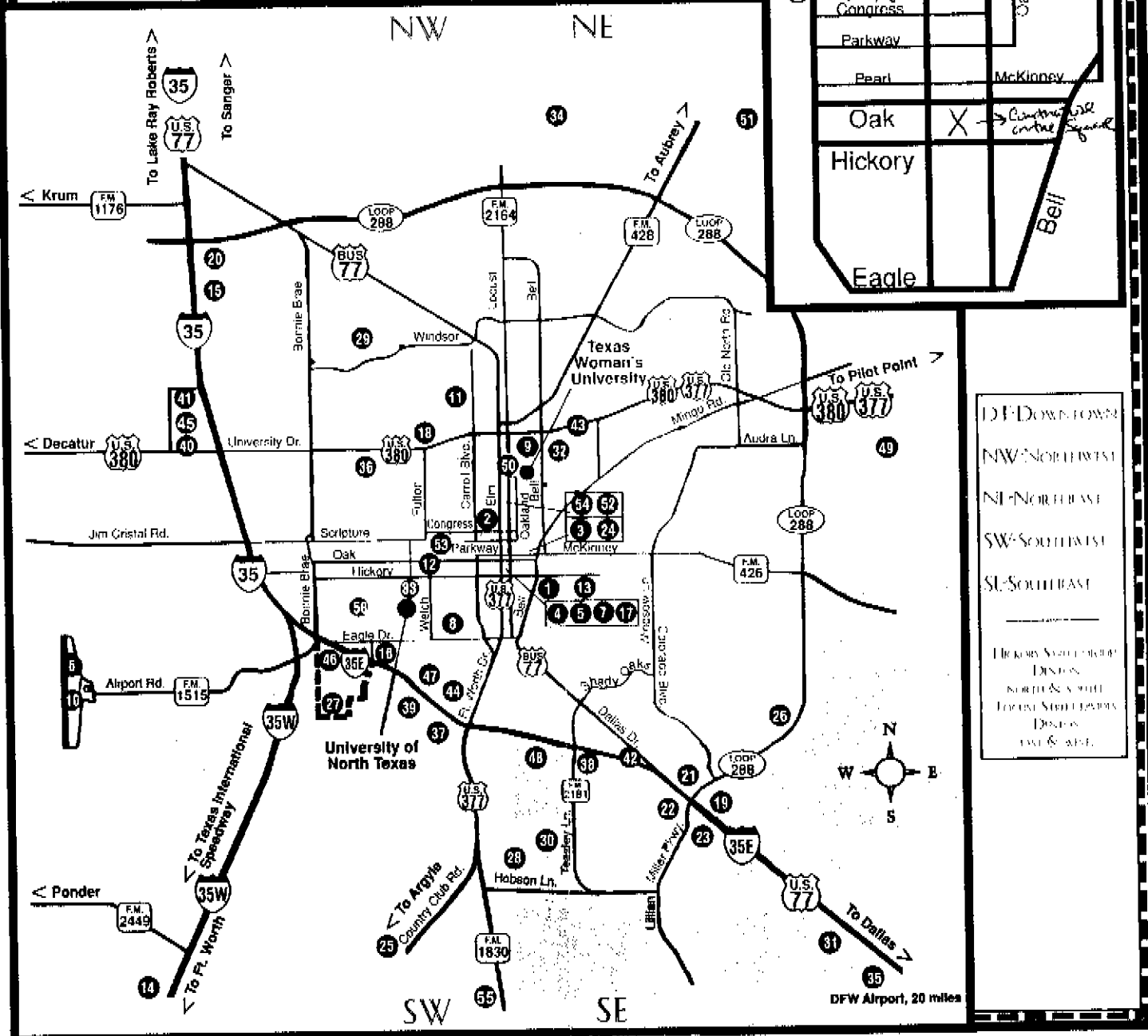

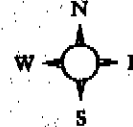
