

#### TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 4.71 million chicks during the week, up 5 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week. The placements were down 3 percent from the first of the month.

The weekly hatch totaled 5.42 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of January 4. The hatch was 5 percent above a year ago but 1 percent below last week.

The egg set increased 7 percent from last year to 6.53 million. The set was up 3 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 672,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

#### NINETEEN STATES

Weekly placements in the the nineteen leading broiler producing states totaled 87.71 million chicks, virtually unchanged from last year. Placements were down 1 percent from a week ago.

The weekly egg set increased 5 percent from last year to 111.77 million eggs. set was up only slightly from the previous
