TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.27 million chicks, an increase of 35 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers hatched 4.93 million chicks, 79 percent of the eggs set during the week of September 7. The hatch was 32 percent above a year ago and virtually unchanged from last week.

The weekly egg set increased 11 percent from last year to 6.28 million. The set was up 12 percent from a week ago.

Texas producers shipped 601,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 81.47 million chicks, up 7 percent from last year but down 4 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set was up 4 percent from The set a year ago to 106.94 million. increased 8 percent from last week.
