

TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.11 million chicks during the week, up 1 percent from last year but down 3 percent from the previous week.

Producers hatched 4.87 million chicks, 80 percent of the eggs set during the week of August 24. The hatch was 3 percent above a year ago but 2 percent below last week.

The weekly set was up 17 percent from a year earlier to 5.92 million eggs. The set dropped 5 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 699,000 broiler chicks to Alabama, Arkansas and Mississippi, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 85.87 million chicks, an increase of 5 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set was up 13 percent from a year ago to 104.19 million. The set was down slightly from last week.
