

## TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.53 million chicks, an increase of 3 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week. Placements were down 2 percent from a month ago.

Producers hatched 5.23 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of June 15. The hatch was up 1 percent from a year ago but down 1 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set totaled 6.14 million eggs, 4 percent above a year earlier and a 6 percent increase from the previous week. set was down 4 percent from a month ago.

Texas producers shipped 701,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

### NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 89.31 million chicks, 2 percent above last year but down 2 percent from the previous week.

The egg set totaled 109.90 million, up 3 percent from a year ago and 5 percent from last week.
