## TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.82 million chicks, an increase of 8 percent from last year and 5 percent from the previous week. However, placements dropped 5 percent from the first of the month.

Texas producers hatched 5.29 million broiler chicks, 80 percent of the eggs set during the week of July 5. The hatch was up 3 percent from a year ago and 9 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set increased 6 percent from a year earlier to 6.52 million. The set

was 2 percent below the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 444,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

## TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 84.36 million chicks, an increase of 4 percent from both last year and the previous week.

The weekly egg set was up 5 percent from last year to 109.39 million. The set was slightly below a week ago.
