NON-CIRCULATING

TEXAS

Texas producers shipped 804,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.46 million chicks, an increase of 3 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 90.34 million chicks, up 3 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers hatched 5.27 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of May 25. The weekly hatch was up 3 percent from a year ago but down slightly from last week.

The weekly egg set, at 112.48 million, was 4 percent above a year ago. The set was down slightly from last week.

The weekly set totaled 6.44 million eggs, an increase of 3 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week.
