NON-CIRCULATING

TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 4.32 million chicks during the week, an increase of 9 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly hatch, at 5.00 million chicks, represented 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of July 27. The hatch was up 7 percent from a year ago but down 1 percent from last week.

Producers set 6.18 million eggs, 7 percent above last year and 1 percent above a week ago.

Texas producers shipped 652,000 broiler chicks to Alabama and Arkansas, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 86.71 million chicks, 2 percent above a year ago but slightly below last week.

The weekly egg set totaled 107.49 million, an increase of 3 percent from a year earlier. The set was down 1 percent from the previous week.
