TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.72 million chicks, up 8 percent from last year but down 3 percent from the previous week.

The weekly hatch, at 5.49 million chicks, represented 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of December 28. The hatch increased 8 percent from a year ago and 3 percent from last week.

The egg set was up 3 percent from last year to 6.37 million; however, the set dropped 3 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 746,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 88.28 million chicks, up 2 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 111.27 million eggs, was 2 percent above a year earlier. The set was down slightly from last week.
