Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.67 million chicks, up 4 percent from a year ago but down 7 percent from the previous week.

Producers hatched 5.09 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of September 27. The set was virtually unchanged from last year but was down 7 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set increased 9 percent from a year earlier to 6.19 million eggs. The set was up 17 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 381,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 80.84 million chicks, an increase of 5 percent from last year and 2 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set totaled 101.10 million, up 10 percent from a year ago. The set was down 6 percent from last week.
