TEXAS

The weekly broiler placements were up 1 percent from last year to 4.52 million chicks. Placements were down 4 percent from the previous week but up 2 percent from a month ago.

Texas producers hatched 5.28 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of April 13. The weekly hatch was up 2 percent from a year ago but down 3 percent from last week.

The weekly set totaled 6.43 million eggs, an increase of 3 percent from a year earlier. The set was 1 percent below last week. Shipments of broiler chicks to Alabama, Arkansas and Mississippi totaled 749,000 during the week. No inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

Producers in the nineteen leading states placed 91.04 million broiler chicks, an increase of 4 percent from last year. Weekly placements were down 1 percent from a week ago.

Egg set totaled 111.89 million, up 4 percent from a year earlier and slightly above last week.
