TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 5.36 million chicks, up 6 percent from last year but down 3 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers hatched 5.61 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week ending June 13. The hatch was virtually unchanged from last year, but down 6 percent from a week ago.

The weekly egg set dropped 5 percent from the previous year to 6.25 million eggs. The set was down 10 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 231,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 91.96 million chicks, an increase of 7 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly set of 109.32 million eggs was down 1 percent from a year earlier and 5 percent from last week.
