TEXAS

The weekly broiler placements totaled 5.49 million chicks, up 4 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week.

Producers hatched 5.91 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of June 6. The hatch was up 3 percent from a year ago and 1 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set increased 14 percent from last year to 6.88 million. The set was down 3 percent from a week ago.

Texas producers shipped 370,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 93.24 million chicks, up 9 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

Producers set 115.53 million eggs, up 9 percent from a year earlier but down 3 percent from last week.
