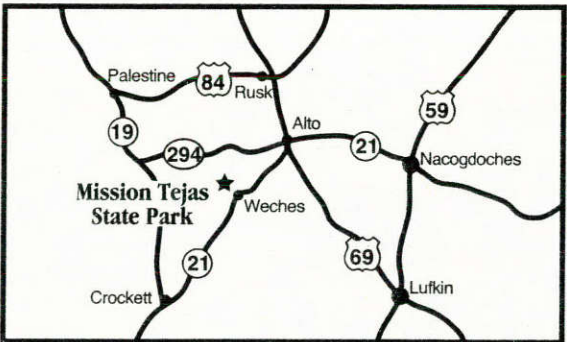
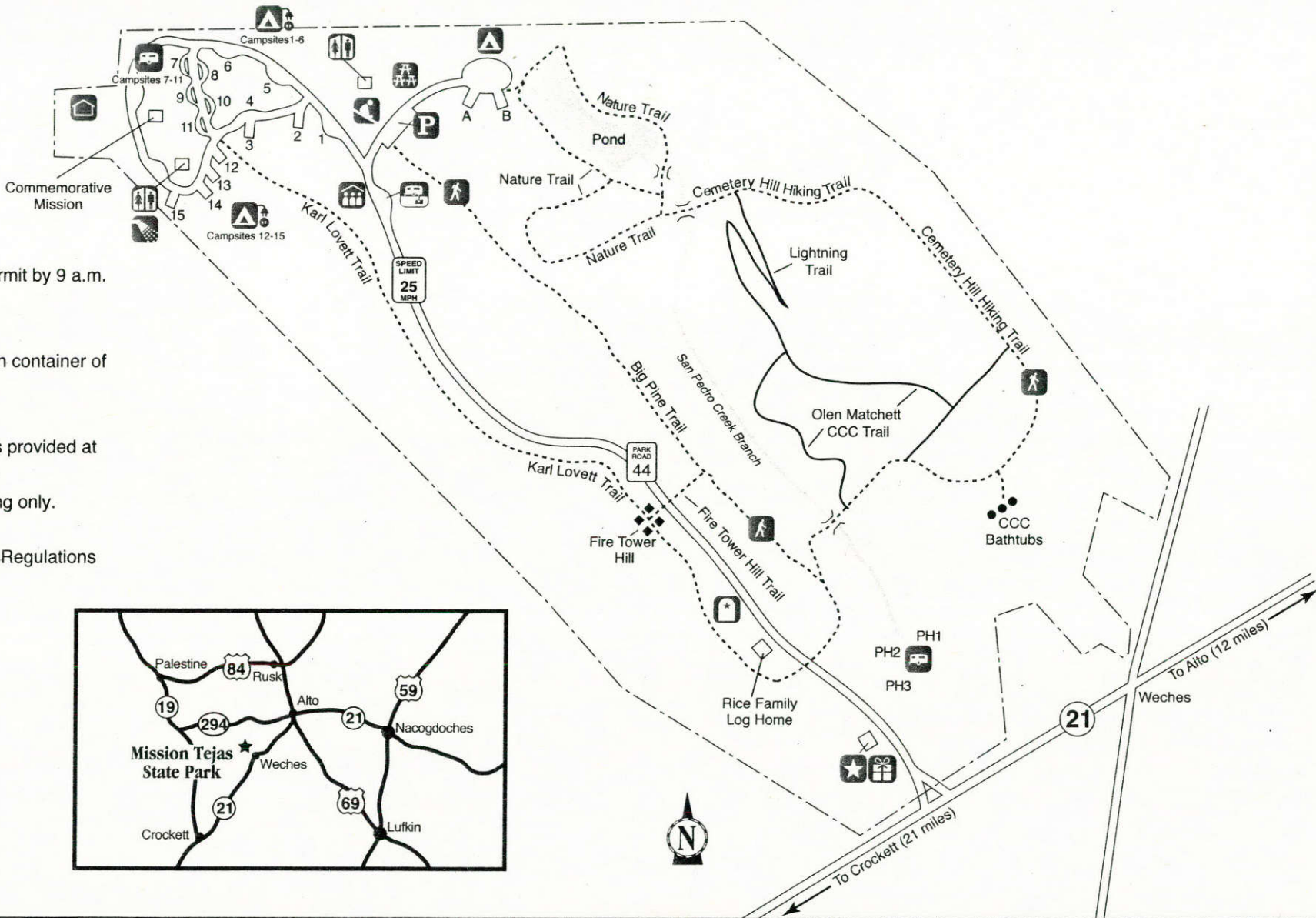




Mission Tejas State Park

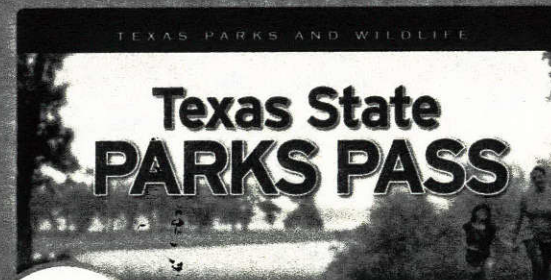


The Bluebonnet license plate is the only plate that gives you the power to make a difference at Texas State Parks by helping to fund natural and cultural resource management and educational programs.

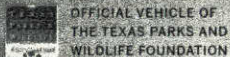
