TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 4.77 million chicks during the week, an increase of 19 percent from last year but down 2 percent from the previous week.

The weekly hatch totaled 5.26 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of November 23. The hatch was up 15 percent from a year ago but down 1 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set was up 10 percent from last year to 6.53 million eggs. The set was 1 percent below the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 417,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled almost 89.49 million chicks, 6 percent above last year and 1 percent below the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 111.34 million eggs, was 6 percent above a year earlier. The set was slightly above last week.
