## AGREEMENT REACHED FOR FIVE STATE PARKS

AUSTIN--Texas Parks and Wildlife Department has entered into an unprecedented contractual agreement to allow the nonprofit organization Texas Rural Communities, Inc. to take over management of five state parks facing budget cuts.

The Texas comptroller's office cited the agreement as an example of re-inventing government to provide services Texans have come to expect, even during lean times.

"Texas Parks and Wildlife and TRC have come up with a unique solution to a problem that faces all state agencies: providing quality services in a time of fiscal constraints," said State Comptroller John Sharp. "This agreement represents an innovative approach to funding parks when there's not enough money to go around. Creating partnerships with local communities is a great example of finding a better way of doing business. That's what our Texas Performance Review report *Against the Grain* is all about."

Sharp's January report encouraged state agencies to "have the courage to cut against the grain of business as usual" in order to boost public service without boosting public cost.

The state parks in the TRC agreement are Eisenhower Birthplace in Denison in North Texas, Fort McKavett near Menard and Fort Lancaster near Ozona in West Texas, and Starr Mansion in Marshall and Caddoan Mounds near Alto in East Texas.

"Our goal was to find creative ways to help these sites thrive," said Andrew Sansom, TPWD executive director. "TRC's goal is to help local communities with economic development. The two go hand in hand.

"The local communities near these parks will have real incentives to get involved and more opportunity for input on plans to improve park facilities, activities, marketing, the whole works," he said. "This agreement is in line with our belief that state government needs to forge partnerships with business and local government wherever possible, and we will continue to encourage this policy at sites across Texas."

The parties to the TRC agreement view it as much more than a simple transfer of management. The broader purpose is to develop and implement regional marketing plans in the Edwards Plateau, the Red River region and East Texas. "The partnership will seek to generate economic activity in these regions through outdoor recreation and through appreciation of cultural and historical resources," Sansom said.

"We believe these parks are tremendous economic development resources that can be used to attract visitors to rural Texas," said Juan Hinojosa, a McAllen attorney and chairman of the board of TRC. "For example, when people come to the Eisenhower Birthplace, they're also going to be attracted to the Rayburn Home nearby, and to local restaurants and other businesses. So, this agreement benefits not only the parks and the taxpayers, but also the local economies."

The TRC agreement represents the crowning achievement of TPWD's Partners In Parks program launched last summer. Faced with declining revenue for parks, TPWD staff had concluded the only way to continue to provide quality services at all state parks was to make businesslike decisions to cut back at a number of sites.

On Aug. 28, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission approved an operating budget that called for cuts at seven state parks and partial reductions at 18 others. In so doing, the commission urged staff to aggressively seek local support for the facilities.

The first site to achieve a partnership breakthrough was Old Fort Parker near Groesbeck in Limestone County. The Groesbeck City Council voted Sept. 29 to take over management of the site, which hosted one of its best-attended special events in recent years three months later on Dec. 19. Under the agreement, TPWD will provide technical guidance and provide some long-term capital funding.

An agreement for another site facing budget cuts, Confederate Reunion Grounds near Mexia, is nearing completion. Under the agreement, a private concessionaire will take over management of the site. This would be similar to existing concession operations like the one at Longhorn Cavern, where a private business runs the facility, yet it remains part of the state park system.

Cassells-Boykin near Zavalla in Angelina County is slated to become a county park by mid-spring. Angelina County will assume the department's lease from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

At numerous other state park sites where partial reductions were planned, big increases in local volunteer support, local government utility cost reductions and other local partnership efforts helped keep almost all sites open at full service levels.

"The bottom line is that no state parks have closed," Sansom said. "I am very proud of our staff, and of our commissioners, who logged hundreds of hours and many miles across Texas to make this possible. But our department's deepest gratitude goes to those local communities who accepted the challenge and came forward with real support to help keep affected sites open. Our agreement with Texas Rural Communities is truly their victory."

### **MOUNTAIN LION REPORTS UP**

AUSTIN--Almost 250 mountain lion sightings and more than 100 mortalities were reported to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department in 1992, many turning up in areas of the state they haven't been seen in before.

The department received 242 verified sightings during the year, coming from all ecological regions except the Blacklands Prairie and the High Plains, said Bill Russ of Sanderson, TPWD's principal investigator for mountain lions. As expected, the Trans-Pecos had 73 verified sightings as did the Edwards Plateau. The Post Oak region had 16 sightings and the Pineywoods two.

"Verified sightings definitely are increasing in the eastern third of the state over the last two years, he said.

One of the most unusual sightings of the year was reported by two fishermen at the J.D. Murphree Wildlife Management Area near Port Arthur. The men reportedly saw the lion in one tree as they were going fishing and in another tree as they returned.

Sightings also were reported along the Red River (two) and the Canadian River near Amarillo.

The department also received information on 127 confirmed mortalities, 72 in the Trans-Pecos. Thirty-nine of the mortalities were reported in the Edwards Plateau, 95 percent of those in Terrell, Val Verde and Crockett counties. There were no confirmed mortalities in East Texas.

A deer hunter took a 150-pound male mountain lion in Llano County. Other examples of some of the areas where lions were taken include near Breckenridge and west of Snyder in Borden County.

"Mountain lions are definitely being spotted in places they haven't been seen in recent times," Russ said.

The department depends upon the public to provide information about mountain lion sightings and kills. If anyone sees or kills a mountain lion they are encouraged to report it to their local wildlife biologist or game warden or call TPWD headquarters in Austin at 1-800-792-1112 or (512) 389-4800.

## **OUTDOOR EXPO POSTER, ESSAY, POETRY CONTEST ANNOUNCED**

AUSTIN--Fifteen fortunate Texas school students will be awarded a lifetime combination hunting and fishing license as winners of the Texas Outdoor Expo '93 poster, essay and poetry contest.

The contest is similar to a contest during Texas Wildlife Expo '92 that presented lifetime licenses to several youngsters for winning posters and essays.

The poster contest is open to students in kindergarten through sixth grade and must be on standard-size poster cardboard (approximately 22 inches by 28 inches) and be in any medium. Students in grades seven through 12 are eligible for the essay contest. Essays must be 500-1,000 words. The new poetry contest is open for students from kindergarten through 12th grade and poems must be 50-500 words.

Winning entries will be published statewide and, in addition to the lifetime hunting and fishing license, winners will receive the Texas Wildlife Viewing Guide and a one-year subscription to Texas Parks and Wildlife magazine. The total value of each prize is more than \$800.

One winner will be selected from each grade level for the poster and essay contests. Two poetry winners will be selected, one in the kindergarten through sixth grade category and another for seventh through 12th graders. All entries will be judged by members of the Texas Outdoor Writers Association.

Deadline for entering the contests is June 1. One entry (either poster, essay or poetry) per individual may be submitted. Winners must be Texas residents. All entries become property of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and will not be returned. Children of the immediate family of TPWD employees are ineligible.

Texas Outdoor Expo '93 is scheduled for Oct. 1-3 at TPWD headquarters in Austin. All winners will be announced and honored at the celebrity banquet on Oct. 1.

This year's theme is "Enjoying the Outdoors- Wisely."

Texas hunters and fishermen have been the primary supporters of conservation programs and game management through the purchases of licenses and outdoor equipment. Other outdoor recreation groups have been invited to support conservation efforts through programs like the Texas Conservation Passport and other public land opportunities.

The expo will specifically celebrate the many years TPWD has had the responsibility of managing the state's natural resources and maximizing the public's opportunities to enjoy outdoor activities in Texas. On Oct. 2-3, the public will be able to see raptor demonstrations, shooting exhibitions, reptile and other live animal displays, fishing, "catch-a-poacher" role playing, seminars, rock climbing demonstrations, educational activities, sporting dog demonstrations, fish exhibits, Indian lore, park displays, animal tracks, shooting, animal calling contests, outdoor industry exhibitions and other activities.

### **KERR WMA SCHEDULES WHITETAIL SEMINARS**

KERRVILLE--From March through October, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department will conduct a white-tailed deer management seminar on the first Friday of each month at the Kerr Wildlife Management Area.

Seminars will be restricted to 50 people and will begin at 1:30 p.m. The first one is scheduled for March 5.

Since 1977, more than 37,000 people have attended white-tailed deer management seminars and related programs on the Kerr area, said George Litton, regional wildlife director in Waco. In 1992, 76 tours were given to 2,442 sportsmen, landowners, students and others interested in wildlife conservation.

The programs emphasize combined livestock and range management practices, including rotational livestock grazing and prescribed fire, as well as deer nutrition, genetics and population control programs. Programs stress an ecological approach to deer management.

## FALL LAKE SURVEYS

AUSTIN--To best determine the state of Texas' fishery, Texas Parks and Wildlife Department fisheries crews conduct net and electrofishing samples during spring and fall. Below are the results from some of the fall samples.

### Coleta Creek Reservoir

Fall electrofishing samples revealed that the reservoir supports a healthy largemouth bass population, said Mike Reed, inland fisheries biologist from Mathis. The sample included fish from two inches to 20 inches, with the greatest abundance of fish in the eight-inch to 15-inch group. Age analysis indicates the bass are reaching the legal size of 14 inches in three years.

Fall frame net samples show a balanced size distribution of white crappie. Fish collected in these nets ranged from two inches to 20 inches. Reed said a good number of fish less than 10 inches long were collected, indicating good recruitment of young fish. Numerous fish from 10-12 inches were collected. These fish average 10 inches by age 2.

The electrofishing survey also showed abundant bluegill and redear sunfish populations for the other fish to eat, many of which were 5-7 inches. Shad were less abundant in the sample but biologists said they are present in good numbers. Shad collected ranged from 3-14 inches, indicating a healthy, stable population structure.

### B.A. Steinhagen Reservoir

Fall electrofishing surveys showed the catch rate per hour on bass increased three-fold in three years, from 43 per hour in 1990 to 139 per hour in 1992. The proportion of legal fish in the population remains low. 12 percent in 1990 and 8 percent in 1992, said Paul Seidensticker, inland fisheries biologist from Jasper

### Striker Lake

This 2,400-acre lake in Rusk County is considered a poor bass lake. Recent sampling showed the size distribution ranged primarily from six inches to 12 inches and the condition of the fish below standard.



For this reason, Seidensticker said, the department has proposed a 14-inch to 18-inch slot limit, five fish bag limit. If approved, the regulation will allow more fish to grow into 14- to 18-inch fish. Catch rates of quality fish should improve in 1994 and 1995. As the numbers of fish increase in the protected size range, anglers should begin to harvest more fish longer than 18 inches in 1995.

#### **Toledo Bend Reservoir**

Electrofishing surveys of bass produced 204 per hour during the fall, a high rate, Seidensticker said. The total catch per hour on Sam Rayburn Reservoir was 216.

Bass longer than 14 inches comprised 25 percent of the population, a 9 percent increase from 1990. The number of bass less than 14 inches collected per hour was 182, much greater than the rate of 103 in 1990, he said.

The increased size and population of bass at Toledo Bend is attributed to a 14-inch minimum, eight fish daily bag limit that went into effect in September 1990. "This harvest restriction protects young bass and builds the fish population," Seidensticker said.

Another contributing factor was the introduction of Florida bass. The influence of Florida bass genes in Toledo Bend has increased from 5 percent in 1991 to 7.5 percent in 1992. The lake record has increased from 9.5 pounds in 1990 to 13.85 pounds in 1992. The lake will continue to be stocked with Florida bass until the population contains a minimum 20 percent Florida bass.

#### **Lake Whitney**

December sampling indicates continued improvement in the crappie population. The recent crappie catch, 32.9 per net, was almost five times higher than catches in 1990 and 1991.

An abundance of legal fish also showed marked increases. In 1990 and 1991, fish 10 inches and longer comprised about 17 percent of the total sample. In the December sample, legal fish accounted for 31 percent of the collection. Fish collected ranged from two inches to 14 inches.

Growth rates for crappie were the best recorded at Whitney in recent years.

AUSTIN: Here is the weekly fishing report as compiled by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for Feb.10:

#### CENTRAL

BASTROP: Water clear, 56 to 60 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 6 pounds on jigs and cranks; crappie are good at night on minnows in 18-22 feet of water; catfish are good through 38 pounds on jigs by a bass fisherman, good numbers of channel catfish in the 3-6 pound range caught on punch and sponge baits.

BELTON: Water clear, 56 degrees, about 7 feet above normal level; black bass have slowed down, some to 4 pounds on jigs and spinners; striper are slow; crappie are good on fleaflyies and minnows; white bass are excellent to 2 1/2 pounds on jigging spoons and slabs; catfish are slow.

BROWNWOOD: Water clear, 58 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 3 pounds on spinners and cranks off points; striper are good in the 18-25 inch range under birds around Johnsons Point and in 35-40 feet of water on slabs and jigs; crappie are good off docks in 30 feet of water around brush piles on jigs; white bass are good at night under lights with some schooling in the lake, limit fairly easy on jigs, spoon, slabs; yellow catfish are slow; channel catfish are good with limits in 2 1/2 to 5 pounds on ghost minnows.

BUCHANAN: Water clear, 57 degrees, 2 feet low; black bass are fair through 4 pounds, 9 ounces on white spinners; striper are excellent to 11 pounds on live bait; crappie are slow; white bass are good around Garrett Island and upriver towards Tow on trolling baits with limits daily; catfish are slow.

CANYON: Water clear, 58 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 3 pounds in 35 to 40 feet of water on silver spoons and Rattle Traps; striper are fair in the 3 1/2 to 4 pound range trolling Phantom Lures, silver spoons and minnows; striper are located just under the white bass schools; catfish are fairly good to 7 1/2 pounds on chicken and rabbit livers and shrimp.

COLORADO BEND: Water clear, 71 degrees, normal level; black bass are poor; striper are poor; crappie are fair on jigs in deeper water with to 8 fish per string; white bass are good with limits caught on with blue or white spinners; however, the main run has not started but should within the next week; yellow catfish are good to 11 pounds on live bait on trotlines in deep water; channel catfish are good to 3 pounds on rod and reel with cut bait and worms in 5-6 feet of water.

FAYETTE: Water clear, 62 degrees, normal level; black bass are excellent to 9 1/2 pounds on water dogs for big fish, good numbers of slot sized bass caught on worms, jerk baits, cranks and spinners, most are caught in 1-8 feet of water but the larger fish are caught in 18 to 25 feet of water; crappie are fair on crappie minnows in 12-20 feet of water in creek beds; catfish are fair to 7 pounds on chicken livers and shad minnows.

GIBBONS CREEK: Water clear, 68 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 11 1/2 pounds on Rattle Traps and lizards; crappie

are slow; catfish are slow to 1 1/2 pounds.

LBJ: Water clear, 57 degrees, lake full; black bass are good to 3 pounds, 9 ounces on chartreuse worms; striper are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are good from 1431 bridge towards the Llano River; catfish are slow.

LIMESTONE: Water clear to murky, 54-58 degrees, normal level; black bass are good through 7 pounds on Bulldog spinners, Jawtec Salty Dog grubs in black and chartreuse, black and blue Salty Dog Lizards and red 5/8-ounce Mud Bugs; crappie are slow due to lack of fishermen, fish should be moving back into the shallows; white bass are slow; catfish are fair to 10 pounds on live perch on and shrimp.

SOMERVILLE: Water a little off color, 58 degrees, 1 foot above normal level; black bass are slow; striper are slow; crappie are good around marinas at night and early morning in 10 feet of water on minnows and jigs; catfish are good in number to 2 pounds on stinkbait and minnows.

SQUAW CREEK: Water clear, 60 degrees, 5-6 feet of visibility; normal level; largemouth bass are good in the 4-5 pound range in 7-10 feet of water on jigs, cranks, shiners and Rattle Traps; smallmouth bass good in the 3 pound range in 6-10 feet of water on worms, cranks and Rattle Traps; striper are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are improving in the 2 pound range in 15 to 20 feet of water on jigs; catfish are good in the 4 pound range in 20-25 feet of water on stinkbait.

STILLHOUSE: Water clear, 61 degrees, 1 foot low; black bass are good; white bass are fair in number on minnows; crappie are good on minnows in 14 to 20 feet of water; catfish are good in the 17 to 18 inch range on stinkbait and dough bait.

TRAVIS: Water clear, 56 degrees, 6 inches below normal level; black bass are fair to 6 1/2 pounds on smoke glitter Fat Getzits, brown jigs and large minnows; Guadalupe bass are good to 15 inches on the same baits; striper are slow; crappie are good to 1 1/2 pounds on minnows in 15 feet of water; white bass are spotty some caught around Reimers, males only so far; catfish are slow.

WACO: Water off color, 53 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 5 1/2 pounds on jigs and spinners; striper are slow; crappie are fair to 1 1/2 pounds on minnows; white bass are fair to 1 1/2 pounds on small Mister Twisters and Rapalas; catfish are slow.

WHITNEY: Water clear, 53 degrees, 2 3/4 feet low; largemouth bass are fair to 8 pounds on cranks and spinners, best fishing is at night; smallmouth bass are fair on spinners to 5 pounds in 15 to 18 feet of water on spinners; striper are good to 10 pounds on Mann Shadows, Sassy Shad are best on cloudy days; crappie are good on minnows and jigs to 1 3/4 pounds in the barges; white bass are good to 2 pounds on Sassy Shad; channel catfish are good 4 pounds, blue catfish are good to 34 pounds on shad and perch baited trotlines; good numbers of fishermen out in the upper lake midweek.

#### NORTHEAST

ATHENS: Water clear, 51 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 6.86 pounds on Power Worms, black and blue Craw Worms, with

limits to 4 1/2 pounds on the points at 14 feet near the deep water; crappie are fair to good on minnows and jigs to 2 1/2 pounds in 40-45 feet of water; some schooling white bass near the bridge; catfish are fair to 3 pounds; yellow catfish are fair to 10 pounds; bream are slow.

BRIDGEPORT: Water clear, 45 degrees, lake full; black bass are slow; striper are slow; crappie are fair to good to 1 3/4 pounds on minnows and jigs; white bass are good with limits on spinners, jigs, and a wide variety of baits; catfish are slow.

CADDO: Water clear, 45 degrees, 6 inches high; black bass are good to 6 1/2 pounds on plastic worms; crappie are very slow to 1 1/2 pounds on minnows; white bass are slow; catfish are good through 2 pounds on minnows and cut bait with trotlines and set hooks.

CEDAR CREEK: Water clear, 48 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 7 pounds on black and blue jigs; crappie are good with limits caught on minnows; catfish are good to 15 pounds on nightcrawler baited trotlines.

FORK: Water clear, 56 degrees, lake full; black bass are good to 12.18 pounds on jigs; crappie are fairly good to 3.18 pounds on minnows in 48 feet of water; catfish are slow.

GRAPEVINE: Water muddy on the upper end, stained to clear on the lower end, 52 degrees, 2.34 feet above normal level; black bass are good to 8.29 pounds on white spinners in 15 feet of water near dropoffs; crappie are good on tube jigs around boat stalls and man-made fish attractors in 15 feet of water on chartreuse or black are best colors; white bass are fair on minnows in Denton Creek area; catfish are good on shrimp and stinkbait.

JOE POOL: Water clear in lake, murky in the creeks, 50 degrees, 10 feet above normal level; black bass are fair to 6 pounds on spinners; crappie are good to 1 1/2 pounds on minnows; white bass are slow; catfish are good to 6 pounds on shad gizzards and shrimp.

LAKE O THE PINES: Water clear, 55 degrees, 3 1/2 feet above normal level; black bass are fairly good to 9.71 pounds on back and blue jig and pig combinations, Rattle Traps and Spinners; crappie are fairly good around the dam on minnows; white bass are fairly good to 2 1/2 pounds around the points on Rattle Traps.

catfish are fairly good to 8 1/2 pounds on trotlines baited with nightcrawlers and live bait.

LAVON: Water clear, 49 degrees, 18 inches high; black bass are good to 3 pounds on plastic lizards and worms; crappie are good on minnows and jigs near the bottom; white bass are slow; catfish are good through 3 pounds on shad.

MONTICELLO: Water clear, 68 degrees, normal level; black bass are fairly good to 7 pounds on water dogs; crappie are fairly good on minnows; catfish are fairly good.

MOSS LAKE: Water a little murky, 44 degrees, 10 inches above normal level; black bass are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are fair to 8 fish per string in deep water on slabs; catfish are slow.

MURVAUL: Water clear, 59 degrees, 5 inches above normal level; black bass are good to 10.8 pounds along with good numbers of 8 pounders on worms, cranks and spinners in 3 feet of water and on jigs in 14 feet of water around 1971 bridge;

crappie are good to 3 pounds with several limits on minnows and jigs around 1971 bridge; catfish are fair to 4 pounds on nightcrawlers and cut shad.

PALESTINE: Water a little murky, 52 degrees, 6 inches high; black bass are good to 11 1/2 pounds on spinners and jigs; striper are slow; crappie are fair to 2 pounds on minnows in 8-12 feet of water; catfish are fair to 12 pounds on trotlines with blood bait and cut bait.

PURTIS CREEK: Water clear, 51 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair in the 3-4 pound range on cranks; crappie are fair in the evenings on minnows; catfish are slow.

RAY HUBBARD: Water clear, 46 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair on spinners near the rocks; striper are slow; crappie are good 1-8 a.m. on minnows and jigs; white bass are slow; catfish are good to 7 pounds on live breem.

RAY ROBERTS: Water clear, 53 degrees, normal level black bass are good to 8 pounds on black and blue jigs; crappie are slow on brush piles; white bass are slow; catfish are good to 7 pounds on shrimp baited rods and reels.

RICHLAND-CHAMBERS: Water clear, normal level; black bass are good to 6 pounds on spinners and jigs in 3-10 feet of water; crappie are slow and are moving into the creeks; catfish are good on trotlines as well as rod and reel baited with shrimp and shad.

TAWAKONI: Water clear, 46 degrees, normal level; black bass are fairly good to 5 pounds on topwaters in the coves, around the rocks at the dam; striper are slow; crappie are fairly good to 2 1/2 pounds around the docks on minnows and jigs; white bass are slow; catfish are good to 6 pounds on bloodbait and Bill's Baits.

TEXOMA: Water clear, 44 degrees, 6 inches low; smallmouth bass are good to 4.6 pounds on FinS Fish; largemouth are good in the 2-3 pound range on FinS Fish and cranks; striper are good to 18.4 pounds on Ponyhead Jigs; crappie are fair on minnows on the bottom; white bass are good with live bait, Sassy Shad and spoons; catfish are excellent to 31 pounds on live bait and cut bait.

#### SOUTHEAST

CONROE: Water fairly clear over most of the lake, murky on the upper end, 53-59 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 9.7 pounds in clear water over the weekend on plastic crawfish; crappie are good under bridges, around brush and boat sheds with minnows and jigs; white bass are fair in number; channel catfish are good to 4 pounds on cheese bait and chicken livers in 18 to 20 feet of water.

HOUSTON COUNTY: Water clear, 54 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 9 pounds on water dogs; crappie are good in shallow water on minnows; white bass are good with limits in the creek below the dam; catfish are good to 7 pounds on rod and reel baited with minnows.

LIVINGSTON: Water a little muddy, normal level; black bass are slow but are beginning to pick up; striper are slow; crappie are fairly good off docks with strings to 20 fish each on minnows; white bass are slow, fish are still up the river; catfish are fairly good in the 2 to 16 pound range on cut shad and live bait.

RAYBURN: Water clear, 60 degrees, 6 inches low; black bass are good to 9 pounds, 14 ounces on blue Craw Worms; crappie are slow around the marina on minnows; white bass are slow; catfish are slow.

TOLEDO BEND: Water clear, 57 degrees, 1 foot low; black bass are fair to 6 1/2 pounds on spinners, Model A Bombers, red Rattle Traps, jigs and Craw Worms, most bass are in 2-10 feet of water; striper are fair to 10 pounds on jigs and live baits near the generators; crappie are fair on shiners in 18 to 20 feet of water; white bass are slow; breem are slow; catfish are fair on cutbait in the 2-6 pound range on trotlines.

#### SOUTH

AMISTAD: Water clear, 56 degrees, 2 feet above normal level; black bass are fairly good to 8 pounds on Tequila Sunrise Power Worms; striper are fair in the 2-3 pound range on Bananahead jigs and larger slabs; crappie are fair in number on minnows in 30 to 40 feet of water; white bass are fairly good up the Devils and Pecos Rivers on minnows and slabs; catfish are good on cheese baits in 40 to 100 feet of water.

BRAUNIG: Water murky, 59 degrees, 6 inches above normal level; black bass are fair to 8 pounds on spinners, worms and artificials; hybrid striper are fair to 3 pounds on chicken liver, Rattle Traps and worms from the bank and boats; blue catfish are slow to 5 pounds on tilapia; channel catfish are fair to 2 1/2 pounds on chicken liver baited trotlines; redbass are fair to 19 1/2 pounds from the bank on crawfish, chicken livers, Rattle Traps and worms.

CALAVERAS: Water murky, 60 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 6 1/2 pounds on cranks and worms; striper are slow; catfish are fair to 2 pounds each on chicken liver, shad, shrimp and nightcrawlers; redbass are fair to 15 pounds on artificials, and tilapia; corvina are slow to 13 pounds.

CHOKO: Water clear, 58 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 11 1/4 pounds on red Power Slugs in 3 feet of water, others baits include spinners, Rattlin' Thinfin, plastic worms, Slug-Gos and topwaters around Mason, Calliham, Greyhound, Salt Creek and Possum Creek and in Three Fingers Cove; striper are slow; crappie are fair around 99 bridge and in the river, some spawning in 3-8 feet of water in the river channel or along the shoreline with heavy cover; white bass are good on live minnows, white grubs and chrome cranks around 99 bridge, good numbers of fish caught around Tilden; catfish are slow, should improve when water hits 60s, some trotline activity at night in 25 to 35 feet of water along the river channel.

COLETO CREEK: Water clear, 57 degrees, 6 inches low; black bass are fair to 7 pounds on various baits up Perdido Creek and at Dike #2; striper are excellent on spoons at Dike #2, some limits caught; crappie are slow due to lack of fishermen; catfish are good to 14 inches plus on trotlines baited with minnows.

CORPUS CHRISTI: Water clear, 59 degrees, 2 1/2 feet low; black bass are fair to 3 1/2 pounds in 3-4 feet of water on minnows and Sassy Shad; striper are fair to 7

1/2 pounds off state park piers on white jigs at night under lights; crappie are slow; white bass are good up the river past the Macaskie Bridge on white Roadrunners and white Small As; blue catfish are good to 21 pounds on trotlines baited with shad; channel catfish are good below the dam on shrimp and shad.

FALCON: Water clear, 62 degrees, 2 feet low; black bass are excellent to 10 1/2 pounds on blue flake Power Worms, a one-day tournament over the weekend required 31.16 pounds to win; striper are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are good up the Rio Grande on Shysters and Blue Fox spinners; catfish are excellent to 5 pounds on rod and reel with frozen shrimp.

MEDINA: Water clear, 2 1/2 feet low; black bass are slow to 4 pounds on Power Worms; striper are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are fair in the river area on L'il Georges or white slabs, no limits; catfish are slow, few fishermen out midweek.

TEXANA: Water muddy, normal level; black bass, white bass and crappie are poor; catfish are fair to 31 pounds on trotlines with cut bait; a few blue catfish in the 3-5 pound range caught on same trotlines.

#### WEST

FORT PHANTOM HILL: Water clear, 48 degrees, 2 feet low; black bass are good to 6 1/2 pounds on jigs, worms and spinners; striper are poor; crappie are fair to good to 1 1/2 pounds on minnows and jigs; white bass are fair in decent numbers on small jigs and cranks; catfish are fair to good to 4 pounds on cut bait.

FRYER: Water clear, near freezing temperature, 6 feet low; no fishermen out midweek, lake just thawed.

GRANBURY: Water off color, 56 degrees, normal level; black bass are fair to 4 pounds on crawdad cranks and medium divers; striper are good to 14 pounds on live bait near the hot water discharge; crappie are fair around brush in 20 feet of water on minnows; white bass are fair up the river around Tin Top under the birds; catfish are good to 6 pounds around baited holes on Mr. Whiskers Cheese Bait.

MEREDITH: Water clear, 37 degrees, normal level; black bass are slow; crappie are slow; white bass are very good on large minnows in 55 feet of water; crappie are slow; walleye are good in the 4-9 1/2 pound range on Count Downs and minnows; catfish are slow.

O.H. IVIE: Main lake clear, upper end murky, 50 degrees, 4 inches low; black bass are good to 20 inches on jigs, Roadrunners and spinners fished slowly in 10-30 feet of water; smallmouth bass are good to 16 inches around points with jigs and slabs in 20-30 feet of water; crappie are good to excellent to 1 3/4 pounds on minnows and jigs along brushy ridges; white bass are slow; channel catfish are fair to good to 8 pounds along river channel in 40 to 80 feet of water; yellow catfish are fair to 10 pounds on trotlines staked along rocky ledges.

POSSUM KINGDOM: Water clear, 46 degrees, 5 feet low; black bass are fair to 4 1/2 pounds on jig and pig combinations and deep diving cranks worked slowly; striper are fairly good in number in the 6-8 pound range on live bait; crappie are fair in 18 to 20 feet of water in the brushy areas

on minnows; white bass are scarce; catfish are slow.

PROCTOR: Water murky, normal level; black bass are fairly good to 5 pounds on minnows and spinners; striped are fair around the minimum size; crappie are fairly good on minnows in 3-4 feet of water; white bass are slow; catfish are slow.

SPENCE: Water clear, 26 feet low; black bass are slow; striped are good to 16 pounds, 5 ounces on slabs and trolling Hellbenders and jigs; crappie are slow; white bass are fair with some good sized fish caught on slabs; catfish are good to 16 1/2 pounds on trotlines baited with cut bait.

STAMFORD: Water clear, 45 degrees, normal level; black bass are good to 4 pounds on buzz baits; striped are slow; crappie are slow; catfish are good to 8 pounds on live bait.

WHITE RIVER: Water clear, normal level; black bass are fair to 3/4 pounds on spoons; crappie are fair but most are too small to keep; catfish are slow.

#### COASTAL

NORTH SABINE LAKE: Fishing has been a little slow; fairly good numbers of fishermen out; some fish caught around the outfall canal; no live bait shrimp available.

SOUTH SABINE LAKE: Water is in good shape; limits of specks caught on the south reef in less than an hour with the rising tide on wildfire tiger worms and FinS Fish; flounder have been improving around Mesquite Point and in the ship channel from Sabine Pass to the intracoastal and also around the causeway bridge, best bait is a mud minnow; redfish are fair at the jetties on dead shrimp; good numbers of sheepshead and drum caught at the jetties on dead shrimp.

GALVESTON: Scattered specks to 6 3/4 pounds in West Bay on live shrimp; scattered flounder to 4 pounds on mud minnows and touts; beach front fishermen are catching whiting and a few oversized redfish; big sheepshead in the 3-5 pound range caught at the jetties; limits of snapper to 12 pounds from the Heald Bank; water is in good condition; live bait is plentiful at \$10 per quart; few fishermen out.

FREEPORT: Fishing has been slow due to the weather; offshore fishermen are catching good numbers of snapper; a few trout caught in the Old River; live bait shrimp available but not plentiful at \$8 per quart. Offshore fishermen have been catching snapper to 19 pounds on squid and ice fish; some amberjack in the 15 to 25 pound range caught in the same area; some trigger fish, a few scamp and gag grouper also caught; several vermillion and Lane snapper also caught.

MATAGORDA: Both Matagorda Bays are full of redfish, on high tide they are feeding near the flats, on low the tide they lay up in deep water; limits caught when fishermen can get out, many throwbacks over 30 inches; speck fishing has been fair around Shell Island in West Matagorda and Raymond Shoals in East Matagorda; live bait shrimp available.

PALACIOS: Fishing has been fairly slow; a few small trout landed; fair numbers trout and specks caught in Green's and Cotton's Bayou on topwaters; no live bait shrimp available.

ROCKPORT: Rains falling midweek;

weather good over the weekend and early this week, redfish were excellent Sunday; good number of trout caught in Copano and Aransas Bays and a good number of redfish caught in Aransas Bay along the San Jose shoreline; Redfish Bay also had trout; good numbers of redfish and trout caught at the jetties over the weekend; some drum caught in Copano; good numbers of fish also caught near Ingleside; live bait shrimp available but not plentiful; pearl, shad, red, clear and chartreuse are good colors.

CORPUS CHRISTI: Nueces Bay fishermen are catching redfish and drum past the second high line on live or dead shrimp; some trout and redfish caught under the causeway bridge; live bait shrimp are available at 15 cents each.

PORT MANSFIELD: A few redfish caught in the East Flats in the evenings; a few shrimp beginning to show; offshore fishermen are catching snapper to 15 pounds at the Steamer Rocks; some live bait available around \$12 per quart.

SOUTH PADRE: The norther last week slowed the fishing considerably; afterwards, the surf was full of whiting and bluefish to 2 pounds on shrimp and gold Johnson Sprites; good numbers of large drum caught in the Brownville Ship Channel on sea lice; good numbers of trout showing up in the bays around Gas Well Flats, Walt's Bar and Laguna Vista Cove; redfish are spotty but a few caught south of Cullen's and in Rattlesnake Cove; snapper fishing has been excellent when boats can get out; pier fishing is good for sandtrout and large sheepshead; a few flounder also caught; live bait shrimp available at \$10 per quart.
