Texas broiler operators placed 5.44 million chicks, an increase of 5 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly hatch totaled 5.76 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week ending June 20. The hatch was up 2 percent from a year ago and 3 percent from last week.

Texas producers set 6.68 million eggs, virtually unchanged from a year earlier. The set was 7 percent above last week. Texas producers shipped 291,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 91.74 million chicks, up 7 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week.
