

TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.67 million chicks, an increase of 9 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week.

Producers hatched 5.39 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of February 1. The hatch was up 6 percent from a year ago and 2 percent from last week.

The weekly set increased 11 percent from last year to 6.98 million eggs. The set was up 3 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 662,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

NINETEEN STATES

Weekly placements in the the nineteen leading broiler producing states totaled 90.20 million chicks, an increase of 5 percent from a year earlier and 3 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 116.11 million, was up 4 percent from a year ago and 1 percent from last week.
