TEXAS

Texas broiler producers placed 4.89 million chicks during the week, up 8 percent from last year but down 7 percent from the previous week.

Producers hatched 5.61 million chicks, 81 percent of the eggs set during the week of May 17. The hatch increased 6 percent from a year ago but decreased 7 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set, at 6.63 million, was 2 percent above a year earlier. The set was 9 percent below last week.

Texas producers shipped 679,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 86.07 million chicks, up 4 percent from last year. Placements were up slightly from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 110.87 million eggs, was 4 percent above a year ago. The set dropped 1 percent from last week.
