

#### TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 5.1 million chicks, up 10 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week. Placements were up 4 percent from the first of the month.

Producers hatched 5.66 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of March 8. The hatch was up 5 percent from a year ago but down 1 percent from last week.

The weekly set increased 8 percent from last year to 7.03 million eggs. The set was slightly above the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 558,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

#### TWELVE STATES

Weekly placements in the the twelve leading broiler producing states totaled 85.95 million chicks, an increase of 4 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 110.02 million, was up 3 percent from a year ago and 2 percent from last week.
