

# Texas Broilers

For week ending June 21, 1986 Released: June 25, 1986

TEXAS

Weekly broiler placements totaled 5.08 million chicks, an increase of 13 percent from last year and 3 percent from the previous week.

Producers hatched 5.71 million chicks, 78 percent of the eggs set during the week of May 31. The weekly hatch was 8 percent above a year ago and slightly above last week.

The weekly egg set, at 6.90 million, was up 12 percent from a year earlier. The set was down slightly from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 632,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama. No inshipments were received during the week.

#### TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled almost 85.50 million chicks, up 3 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set increased 7 percent from a year earlier to 111.13 million. The set was slightly above last week.
