

TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 4.89 million chicks during the week, an increase of 14 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous week.

The weekly hatch totaled 5.31 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of November 16. The hatch was up 7 percent from a year ago and 2 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set increased 11 percent from last year to 6.61 million eggs. The set was 1 percent above the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 400,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled almost 90.20 million chicks, an increase of 6 percent from last year and 2 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 110.82 million eggs, was 6 percent above a year earlier but 2 percent below last week.
