Weekly broiler placements totaled 4.75 million chicks, an increase of 11 percent from last year but down 1 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers hatched 5.32 million broiler chicks, 79 percent of the eggs set during the week of July 12. The hatch was up 6 percent from a year ago and 1 percent from last week.

The weekly egg set increased 9 percent from a year earlier to 6.62 million. The set was up 2 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 444,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.
