TEXAS

Texas producers shipped 594,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas. No inshipments were received during the week.

Texas poultry producers placed 4.68 million broiler chicks during the week, up 9 percent from last year and 3 percent from the previous week.

NINETEEN STATES

Weekly placements in the the nineteen leading broiler producing states totaled 87.31 million chicks, up 3 percent from a year earlier and slightly above last week.

The weekly hatch totaled almost 5.30 million chicks, 80 percent of the eggs set during the week of January 25. The hatch was 6 percent above a year ago and 2 percent above last week.

The weekly egg set increased 3 percent from last year to 115.32 million. The set was down 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly egg set, at 6.76 million, was up 8 percent from last year and unchanged from the previous week.
