TEXAS

The weekly broiler placements totaled 4.88 million chicks, an increase of 17 percent from last year but down 2 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers hatched 5.39 million chicks, 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of December 14, 1985. The weekly hatch was 12 percent above a year ago but slightly below last week.

The egg set, at 6.59 million, was up 7 percent from a year earlier but down 1 percent from last week.

Texas producers shipped 466,000 proiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama, while no inshipments were received.

NINETEEN STATES

In the nineteen leading broiler producing states, weekly placements totaled 87.87 million chicks, up 6 percent from last year and 1 percent from the previous week.

The weekly set increased 2 percent from last year to 111.89 million eggs. was up slightly from a week ago.
