68TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE BILL 179

Sec. 58. DISTRIBUTION OF REPORTS. No unit of government covered under Articles I through IV of this Act shall expend funds for the purpose of distributing reports, pamphlets or other printed matter to members of the Legislature and other State officials unless they have complied with the following provisions:

- a. Agencies designated above shall deposit copies of all printed matter prepared for distribution with the Legislative Reference Library.
- b. Agencies desiring to make distribution to members of the Legislature and other State officials shall send notification that the material is on file and upon request of the person notified shall mail the number of copies requested.

Provided that these restrictions shall not prevent the mailing of reports required by general law.

The Legislative Reference Library has compiled this bibliography to assist legislators in their efforts to keep up with state publications and with state agency activities. Some of the items listed herein were published for very limited distribution (minutes, special studies contracted by the agency with outside corporations, etc.); however, one or two copies have been placed in the Library for your convenience and are available for CHECK-OUT. Those publications normally distributed to legislators (annual reports, audits, periodicals and monographs) are also available for CHECK-OUT. Unfortunately, space limitations will not allow the Library to keep extra copies for give-away --- these must be obtained from the issuing agency.

Publications are listed alphabetically by title beneath the agency which is responsible for its publication. Agencies are arranged alphabetically by distinctive word (Land Office -- not General Land Office). Following are University publications alphabetically by college.

When titles are not self-explanatory, brief annotations have been included. Special features are noted.
