



Land lines from maps made by oil companies and the county surveyor

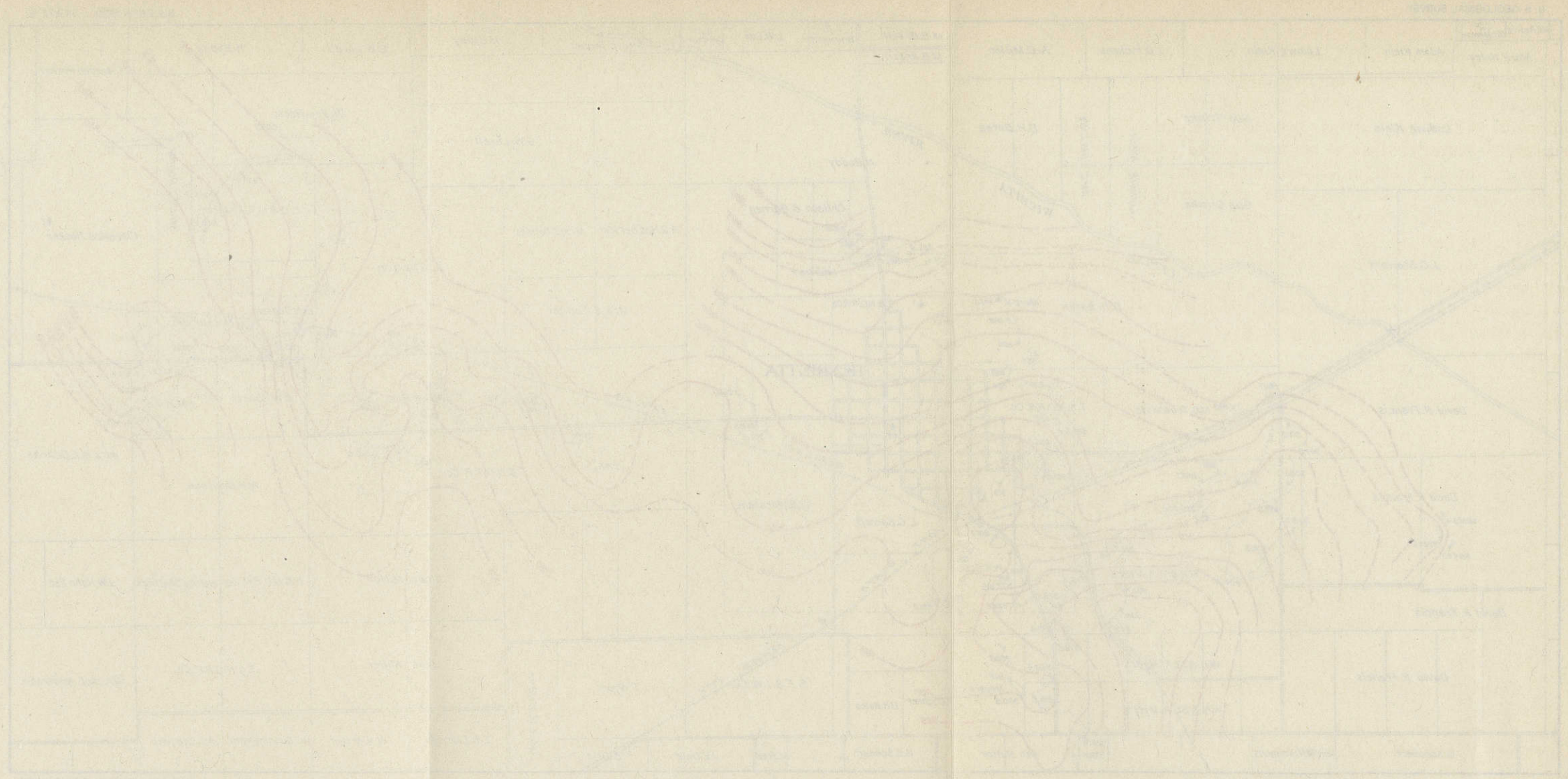

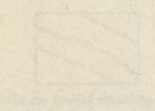
