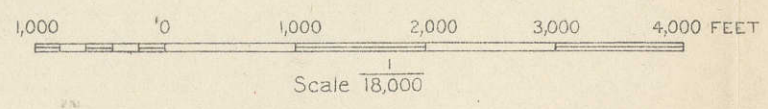


**LEGEND**

**MAP OF THE PETROLIA GAS FIELD TEXAS**

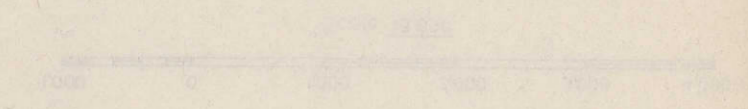
