6	(d) Notwithstanding any other law, a licensed authorized
7	organization may offer and award as a bingo prize under this chapter
8	a ticket for a charitable raffle conducted under Chapter 2002. The
9	bingo prize amount is the cost to purchase the ticket to enter the
10	charitable raffle for purposes of this chapter.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15	Act takes effect September 1, 2017.


