Chapter 309

S.B. No. 867

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the designation of United States Highway 287 in
3 Armstrong and Donley Counties as the Colonel Charles Goodnight
4 Memorial Highway.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
7 is amended by adding Section 225.123 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 225.123. COLONEL CHARLES GOODNIGHT MEMORIAL
9 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of United States Highway 287 from the
10 eastern corporate limits of Claude to Clarendon in Armstrong and
11 Donley Counties is designated as the Colonel Charles Goodnight
12 Memorial Highway.

13 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
15 designation as the Colonel Charles Goodnight Memorial Highway and
16 any other appropriate information; and

17 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
18 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.
