- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.065, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.065. NOTICE AND RECORD OF SALE. (a) The
- 8 commissioner shall send a written notice of the sale of a tract of
- 9 <u>public school land to [notify</u>] the county clerk of the proper county
- 10 that includes [of the sale of each tract of land,] the name and
- 11 address of the purchaser  $[\tau]$  and the price of the land.
- 12 (b) After receiving a notice of the [being informed of any]
- 13 sale of public school land, the county clerk shall record the notice
- 14 at no charge in the official public records of the county [enter in
- 15 his books opposite the description of the land sold, the name of the
- 16 purchaser and the date of the sale].
- 17 (c) The notice of sale <u>is a</u> [and the book containing the
- 18 entry are] public record [records].
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 51.066(c), Natural Resources Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- (c) One copy of the land award shall be retained in the land
- 22 office, one [and the other] copy shall be sent to the purchaser, and
- 23 one copy shall be sent to the county clerk of the proper county to be
- 24 recorded at no charge in the official public records of the county.

- SECTION 3. Section 51.176(c), Natural Resources Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (c) The county clerk shall mark the exact date and hour of
- 4 filing on the original and a duplicate copy of the vacancy
- 5 application and shall return a marked copy to the person filing the
- 6 application. The original shall be recorded in the official public
- 7 records of the county [a book kept for that purpose separate from
- 8 the deed or real property records]. The failure to record a vacancy
- 9 application as provided by this subsection does not affect the
- 10 validity of the application filing.
- SECTION 4. Section 12.0011, Property Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) This section does not apply to a notice of sale under
- 14 Section 51.065, Natural Resources Code, or a land award under
- 15 <u>Section 51.066</u>, <u>Natural Resources Code</u>.
- SECTION 5. Sections 51.065 and 51.066, Natural Resources
- 17 Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to a sale of property that
- 18 occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. For the purposes
- 19 of this section, a sale of property occurs before the effective date
- 20 of this Act if the contract binding the purchaser to purchase the
- 21 property is entered into before that date. A sale of property that
- 22 occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 23 in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in
- 24 effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
