IN RE: SB46 by Zaffirini (Relating to allowing judges to use juror identification numbers when polling the jury.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would permit a judge to assign each juror an identification number to allow for anonymous polling of the jury.
