1 WHEREAS, March 1, 2017, is University of Houston--Victoria 2 Day at the State Capitol, and the occasion provides a fitting 3 opportunity to recognize those associated with this notable 4 institution; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1973, the University of 6 Houston--Victoria boasts more than 18,000 alumni, including 7 acclaimed author and artist Van G. Garrett, and is meeting higher 8 education needs in a city that is home to over 67,000 people and 9 that serves as a regional hub for the seven-county area known as the 10 Golden Crescent; and

11 WHEREAS, UHV educates approximately 4,100 students annually with about 1,000 graduates each year; the university offers 70 12 13 bachelor's and master's degree programs with concentrations in the 14 fields of arts and sciences, business administration, health professions, and human development; it was the first public 15 university in Texas to offer an accelerated bachelor's degree 16 program, and it has been ranked as the fourth most affordable 17 18 college in Texas; and
