4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:


5 SECTION 1. Section 11001.007(a), Special District Local
6 Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:


7 (a) The board by resolution may impose a monthly charge in

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.




