8	(a) The portion of State Highway 95 in Lavaca County from the
9	northern municipal limits of Shiner to the southern municipal
10	limits of Moulton is designated as the Sergeant David M. Furrh
11	Memorial Highway.
12	(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:
13	(1) design and construct markers indicating the
14	designation as the Sergeant David M. Furrh Memorial Highway and any
15	other appropriate information; and
16	(2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
17	appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
