9	CHAPTER 8005. LAKEWOOD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 3				
10	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS				
11	Sec. 8005.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:				
12	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.				
13	(2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on				
14	Environmental Quality.				
15	(3) "Director" means a board member.				
16	(4) "District" means the Lakewood Municipal Utility				
17	District No. 3.				
18	Sec. 8005.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a				
19	municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,				
20	Texas Constitution.				
21	Sec. 8005.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION				
22	REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to				
23	confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent				
24	directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.				
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1 Sec. 8005.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The 2 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8005.003 until each municipality in whose corporate limits 3 or extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located 4 has 5 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district. 6 7 Sec. 8005.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. 8 9 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

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10 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by 11 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and 12 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that 13 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, 14 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 15 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

<u>Sec. 8005.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY.</u> (a) The
 <u>district is initially composed of the territory described by</u>
 <u>Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.</u>

(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
 does not affect the district's:

23 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

24 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes 25 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 26 interest on a bond;

27 (3) right to impose a tax; or

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1	(4) legality or operation.
2	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
3	Sec. 8005.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
4	governed by a board of five elected directors.
5	(b) Except as provided by Section 8005.052, directors serve
6	staggered four-year terms.
7	Sec. 8005.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
8	September 1, 2017, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed
9	value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to
10	the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary
11	directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission
12	shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the
13	petition.
14	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:
15	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
16	Section 8005.003; or
17	(2) September 1, 2021.
18	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
19	Section 8005.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have
20	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
21	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
22	expire on the earlier of:
23	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
24	Section 8005.003; or
25	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
26	appointment or reappointment.
27	(d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a

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1 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district 2 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the 3 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as 4 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 5 6 petition. 7 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES Sec. 8005.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has 8 9 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for which the district is created. 10 11 Sec. 8005.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 12 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, 13 14 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 15 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 16 Sec. 8005.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design, 17 18 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate, 19 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for 20 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 21 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 22 Sec. 8005.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 23 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, 24 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial 25 26 jurisdiction the road project is located. 27 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits

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1	or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
2	project must meet all applicable construction standards,
3	subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
4	the road project is located.
5	(c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
6	Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
7	specifications of the road project.
8	Sec. 8005.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE
9	OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable
10	requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under
11	Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the
12	creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the
13	<u>district.</u>
14	Sec. 8005.106. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
15	be divided into two or more districts only if:
16	(1) the district has no outstanding bonded debt;
17	(2) the district is not imposing ad valorem taxes; and
18	(3) the requirements of Subsection (i), as applicable,
19	are satisfied.
20	(b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
21	division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
22	duties of the district.
23	(c) A new district created by the division of the district
24	may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
25	outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this
26	chapter.
27	(d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition

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1	signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of					
2	the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the					
3	<u>district.</u>					
4	(e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district					
5	before or after the date the board holds an election under Section					
6	8005.003 to confirm the district's creation.					
7	(f) An order dividing the district shall:					
8	(1) name the new district;					
9	(2) include the metes and bounds of each new district;					
10	(3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;					
11	and					
12	(4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities					
13	between the district and each new district.					
14	(g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of					
15	an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order					
16	with the commission and record the order in the real property					
17	records of each county in which the district is located.					
18	(h) A new district created by the division of the district					
19	shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by					
20	Section 8005.003.					
21	(i) If the district is located wholly or partly in the					
22	corporate limits or the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a					
23	municipality, the district may not divide under this section unless					
24	the municipality by resolution or ordinance consents to the					
25	division of the district. If the district is not located wholly or					
26	partly in the corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of					
27	a municipality, the district may not divide under this section					

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1	unless the commissioners court of each county in which the district
2	is wholly or partly located first adopts a resolution or order in
3	support of the division of the district.
4	(j) Any new district created by the division of the district
5	must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter
6	approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue
7	bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes.
8	SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 8005.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS.
10	(a) The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
11	obligations secured by revenue other than ad valorem taxes.
12	(b) The district must hold an election in the manner
13	provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
14	before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
15	payable from ad valorem taxes.
16	(c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
17	taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
18	vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
19	election held for that purpose.
20	Sec. 8005.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
21	authorized at an election held under Section 8005.151, the district
22	may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
23	the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.
24	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
25	exceed the rate approved at the election.
26	Sec. 8005.153. WATER AND SEWER RATES. Notwithstanding any
27	other law, the district shall establish the same rates for

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1 residential and commercial classes of customers for the provision 2 of water and sewer services. For purposes of this section, the commercial class may not include apartment complexes or other 3 multifamily dwellings. 4 5 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS 6 Sec. 8005.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER 7 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees, 8 9 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any 10 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district 11 purpose. 12 Sec. 8005.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district 13 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the 14 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all 15 16 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner 17 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code. 18 Sec. 8005.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations 19

20 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u>
21 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u>
22 <u>real property in the district.</u>

The Legislative Budget Board, in cooperation with the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), has determined that:

This bill amends the Special District Local Laws Code by adding Chapter 8004 which creates the Lakewood Municipal Utility District No. 2 (District) with the powers and duties of a standard water control and improvement district under Water Code Chapters 49 and 54.

Population - The very specific description of the proposed boundaries does not allow staff to develop precise population estimates. Based on the Original Texas Land Surveys mentioned in SB 2277, staff is unable to determine a population estimate.

Population growth in the specific area since the 2010 census is unknown. The 2010 population estimate for areas of Harris County served by small systems or private wells (County-Other) is 204,630. The Harris County-Other population projections approved for the 2017 State Water Plan projects the population to grow to 245,944 in 2020, 291,438 in 2030 and 311,968 in 2040.

Location - The Proposed district's initial boundaries are described with a combination of Original Texas Land Surveys, Harris County Real Property Records and metes and bounds. Due to the complexity of these boundaries for the various sub areas of the district, staff is able to determine only the general location of the proposed district.

The proposed district's area is approximately 5.75 square miles in northeastern Harris County, located east of the City of Houston and the San Jacinto River. The proposed district does not appear to overlap any existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) boundary.

Comments on Powers/Duties Different from Similar Types of Districts: The Senate Engrossed version removes language that prohibited use of eminent domain outside the district boundaries to acquire a site or easement for a recreational facility or a road project; the engrossed version also removes language that specifies that Special District Local Laws Code as added by Section 1 of this Act only takes effect if this Act receives a two-thirds vote of members elected to each house; the engrossed version also revises the metes and bounds description to contain 1,942.08 acres instead of 1,339.42 acres.

This bill amends the Special District Local Laws Code by adding Chapter 8005 which creates the Lakewood Municipal Utility District No. 3 (District) with the powers and duties of a standard municipal utility district under Water Code Chapters 49 and 54, with the following exceptions; the bill requires the TCEQ to appoint the five initial temporary directors upon receipt of a petition from the owners of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the District; this bill grants the District authority for road projects; the bill allows the District to divide; the bill specifies that at the time of issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of real property in the District; if the bill does not receive a two-thirds vote of all members elected to each house, the District may not exercise the power of eminent domain.

Overlapping Services: TCEQ does not have mapping information for water and/or wastewater providers because this function was transferred from the TCEQ to the Public Utility Commission on September 1, 2014. As a result, TCEQ is unaware of possible overlapping service providers.

TCEQ's Supervision: As with general law districts, the TCEQ will have general supervisory authority, including bond review authority and review of financial reports.

Water Use - SB 2277 specifies that "the district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of the state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution".

Within Harris County, 26 percent of the total water use was groundwater (Gulf Coast and other Aquifers) in 2014. Eighty two percent of all the groundwater pumping was for municipal use. The water source of the proposed district might pursue is unknown.
