

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment on professional sports team
2 charitable foundations conducting charitable raffles.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 47(d-1), Article III, Texas
5 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

6 (d-1) The legislature by general law may permit a
7 professional sports team charitable foundation to conduct
8 charitable raffles under the terms and conditions imposed by
9 general law. The law may authorize the charitable foundation to pay
10 with the raffle proceeds reasonable advertising, promotional, and
11 administrative expenses. A law enacted under this subsection
12 applies [~~may apply~~] only to an entity [~~that is~~] defined as a
13 professional sports team charitable foundation under that law [~~on~~
14 ~~January 1, 2016,~~] and may only allow charitable raffles to be
15 conducted at games hosted at the home venue of the professional
16 sports team associated with a professional sports team charitable
17 foundation. In this subsection, "professional sports team" means:

18 (1) a team organized in this state that is a member of
19 Major League Baseball, the National Basketball Association, the
20 National Hockey League, the National Football League, Major League
21 Soccer, the American Hockey League, the East Coast Hockey League,
22 the American Association of Independent Professional Baseball, the
23 Atlantic League of Professional Baseball, Minor League Baseball,
24 the National Basketball Association Development League, the


1 National Women's Soccer League, the Major Arena Soccer League, the
2 United Soccer League, or the Women's National Basketball
3 Association;

4 (2) a person hosting a motorsports racing team event
5 sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing
6 (NASCAR), INDYCar, or another nationally recognized motorsports
7 racing association at a venue in this state with a permanent seating
8 capacity of not less than 75,000;


9 (3) an organization hosting a Professional Golf
10 Association event; or

11 (4) any other professional sports team defined by law.

12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment on professional sports
16 team charitable foundations conducting charitable raffles."




