- 12 (b) The governing body of a district by order may include in
- 13 the district a portion of a road or public right-of-way, including
- 14 associated drainage areas, or county-owned property that is being
- 15 <u>used for a public purpose if:</u>
- 16 (1) the road, public right-of-way, or county-owned
- 17 property [that] is located in a municipality located in the county
- 18 that created the district; and
- (2) [if] the municipality consents to the inclusion.
- 20  $\underline{(b-1)}$  An election is not required to approve an order
- 21 described by <u>Subsection (b)</u> [this subsection].
- (c) The district may use money available to the district to
- 23 perform any function of the district under this chapter
- 24 [maintenance or improvement] on a road or public right-of-way,

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- 1 <u>including</u> [and the] associated drainage areas, or any property
- 2 included in the district in accordance with this section.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize certain county assistance districts in certain counties to expand the range of projects they may engage in to include public right-of-ways and county-owned property.

This bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

### **Local Government Impact**

According to Fort Bend County, the bill will have a positive impact on the County by allowing the Districts that will benefit to use District funds to perform any function under the authority of the District that would otherwise fall on the County. This will specifically allow these improvements and maintenance functions to be funded by the individuals conducting business within the District rather than being supplemented by the county-wide taxpayers. It is not possible to estimate the fiscal impact at this time.
