5	SECTION 1. Section 253.1611, Election Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
7	follows:
8	(e) This section does not apply to a political contribution
9	made to the principal political committee of the state executive
10	committee or a county executive committee of a political party that

12	[ <del>(1) is made in return for</del> ] goods or services,
13	including political advertising or a campaign communication, <u>to or</u>
14	for the benefit of judicial candidates [the value of which
15	substantially equals or exceeds the amount of the contribution; or
16	[ <del>(2) is in an amount that is not more than the</del>
17	candidate's or officeholder's pro rata share of the committee's
18	normal overhead and administrative or operating costs].
19	(e-1) This subsection applies only to a political party
20	required to nominate candidates by primary election. This section
21	does not apply to a political contribution made, for the purpose of
22	sponsoring or attending an event, to a political committee
23	affiliated with:
24	(1) an organization that has been designated as an

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1 auxiliary, coalition, or county chair association of a political 2 party as provided by political party rule or state executive 3 committee bylaw; or 4 (2) a local chapter of an organization described by 5 Subdivision (1). 6 SECTION 2. Section 253.1611(f), Election Code, is repealed. 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 11


