4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:


5 SECTION 1. Section 1071.053, Special District Local Laws
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 1071.053. BALLOT APPLICATION [~~PETITION~~]. A person who
8 wants to have the person's name printed on the ballot as a candidate
9 for director must file with the board secretary an application in
10 accordance with Chapter 144, Election Code [~~a petition requesting~~
11 ~~that action. The petition must be:~~


12 [~~(1) signed by at least 25 registered voters, and~~

13 [~~(2) filed not later than the 25th day before the date~~
14 ~~of the election]~~.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.




